Corporation Committee Accepts Currier Report on That Item and Decides Against Company on Matter of Street Pavement and Maintenance

Fredericton (N. B.), April 15-A compromise arrange ment under which the city loses the important point and gains a minor one was arrived at by the corporations committee of he legislature in their decision on the New Brunswick Power In the maill
jority, agreed to accept the report of the Currier commission, thus fixing the amount on which the company is entitled o returns at $\$ 2,800,000$.

The city loses on this the chief feature of the bill, as the city's contention has 'keen that the rate base should be the amount arrived at by C. W. Whiting, the city's expert enginralue was $\$ 1,850,000$ and that this was the outside amount on which the company was entitled to a return.

On the other hand the city wins in the matter of extra charges for street pavement and maintenance. The commit-
tee adopted the city amendment relating to this matter providtee adopted the city amendment relating to this matter provid-
ing that the company must pay $\$ 500$ per mile per year for the ing that the company must pay $\$ 500$ per mile per year ror the
upkeep of the streets through which their rails run, remove upkeep of the streets through which their rails rais, on double tracked streets, and also pay for the foundations under their track sections in streets on which the city lays permanent ,
ASSESSMENT AND TAXATION.
The question of assessment and taxation stands over, as this already is fixed by the assessment act adopted by the legislature last year. This may, however, be dealt with when the
