The report on the sanitary condition of the City of Toronto for the year 1901 was issued yesterday. It affords matter for much reflection, not only on the Medical Officer, but on the dangers we have passed and those which still confront us.

The causes of preventable diseases, Dr. Norman Allen states, remain largely the same and the death-rate in the past year from this class of diseases has been high. The severe outbreaks of diphtheria and typhoid fever have been traced to specific unsanitary conditions.

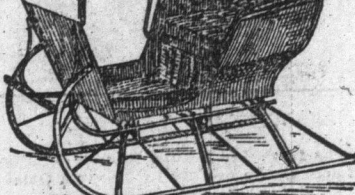
