RULES.

1. The Association shall be styled "THE OTTAWA RIFLE CLUB," and its object shall be the encouragement of Rifle Shooting.

2. The Annual Meeting shall take place each year on the second Tuesday in April. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to call a Special General Meeting whenever required to do so on requisition, in writing, signed by at least five members. Subjects intended to be considered shall be specified. Questions for decision at all meetings to be decided by show of hands. Seven to form a quorum for the transaction of business.

3. The officers of the Club shall consist of a President, first and second Vice-Presidents, and a Secretary-Treasurer. They shall be elected annually, by the members present at the annual meeting, by ballot; a



clear majority of the votes cast being required to elect a candidate.

4. There shall be two Auditors appointed at the annual meeting, by ballot.

5. The President, Vice-Presidents and Secretary-Treasurer, together with three other members elected, by ballot, at the annual meeting, shall constitute a Committee of Management. Three to form a quorum.

6. The Secretary-Treasurer shall submit his accounts, with vouchers attached, to the Auditors at least *one* month prior to the annual meeting, who shall report thereon, and certify to their correctness.

7. Gentlemen desirous of becoming members of the Club will be elected by being introduced and seconded by two members of the Club, and their names in writing handed to the Secretary.

8. Any member may be expelled from the Club by a motion made to that effect,

and supported by a two-thirds vote, by ballot, of the members present at a general or special meeting. Notice of such motion to be given by the mover at a general or special meeting previous to that which he intends to move it, and the Secretary shall immediately notify the member whom it is proposed to expel, that such notice of motion has been given.

9. An annual subscription of two dollars must be paid by each member before engaging in the firing for the year. Any member neglecting to pay his dues shall forfeit his membership, and shall not be eligible for re-election.

10. In the event of the funds of the Club not being found adequate to the payment of its liabilities, the Committee of Management shall have power to levy such an assessment as will provide for the deficiency.

11. The regulations for target practice, and also for the selection of teams, shall be

determined by the Committee of Management. Firing to be in accordance with Dominion Rifle Association rules, except where otherwise decided.

The result of each day's practice shall be recorded in a score book, kept for that purpose by the Secretary.

12. No person, not a member, shall be allowed to shoot at the Club ranges, unless by special permission of the Managing Committee, or in the absence of a quorum of the Committee, by the unanimous consent of the members present; but visitors from a distance, when introduced by a member, may have that privilege.

13. No alterations shall be made in these Rules, except at a general or special meeting, after one month's previous notice; and all alterations must receive a two-thirds vote of the members present.
