TWENTY-SEVENTH ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
Irish Protestant Benevolent Society
OF TORONTO.

To the Members of the Irish Protestant Benevolent Society :

GENTLEMEN,--Your Council have now the pleasure of submitting for your approval the Twenty-Seventh Annual Report, which embraces features upon which we believe the Society has reason to congratulate itself. A perusal of the Report of the Charitable Committee is, we think, sufficient evidence of the value of such an organization as we have, and fully attests the benefit we are enabled, through united and organized effort, to confer upon such of our countrymen as stand in need of assistance. Although it is gratifying that we have been able to do so much in the way of charitable work, yet it should be noted that more could have been done had the funds been provided, and in this connection we would urge upon the members the desirability of largely increasing our numbers, in order that our sphere of influence and usefulness may be materially enlarged. We think that if the Irish Protestant citizens could be more generally impressed with the fact that the objects of the Society are truly charitable there would be less difficulty in enlisting their sympathy and support.

In the matter of distributing our assistance we desire to impress upon the members that every application for relief is personally and thoroughly investigated, and the members can rest assured that the charity of the Society is only dispensed to those who are really deserving of the same.

MEETINGS.

During the past year there have been held eight regular meetings of the Society and ten meetings of the Council, and we are pleased to be able to state that the attendance has shown an increase over that for the previous year. Special mention should be made of the meeting held on the 10th of December, at which a most entertaining musical programme was furnished by the Entertainment Committee, and we are also indebted to Messrs. William Wilson and Henry O'Hara for the very interesting addresses which they gave the Society upon their visit to the "Old Land," and to Mr. Ziba Gallagher for the excellent paper he read upon the life of the Irish poet, Thomas Moore. It is to be hoped that in the coming year our meetings will be made continuously interesting and instructive, as a result of the efforts of the Entertainment Committee.

QUEEN'S JUBILEE.

Perhaps the most memorable event which came under our notice during the past year was the commemoration of the Sixtieth Anniversary of Her Majesty's Coronation. Your Council thought it right and proper that the loyal sentiments of the Irish Protestants in this city should be conveyed to Her Majesty, and therefore despatched the following cable message :

"SIR A. BIGGE,

Private Secretary to the Queen :

"The Irish Protestant Benevolent Society of Toronto respectfully congratulates Her Most Gracious Majesty, and earnestly prays 'God Save our Queen.'"

In reply to this message, we received, by command of Her Majesty, the following letter :

"The Queen has been pleased to command that her thanks should be conveyed to the members of the Irish Protestant Benevolent Society for their Address of Congratulation, an evidence of the devoted attachment of the Society, which affords Her Majesty much gratification.

In further commemoration of the event the Society took part in the procession and service in St. James' Church, on the 20th of June, and likewise took a conspicuous part in the Jubilee Parade on the 22nd idem.

ANNUAL SERMON.

The Annual Sermon of the Society was preached in Cooke's Presbyterian Church, Queen Street East, on the 13th ult., at 4 o'clock in the afternoon, by the Rev. Mr. McCaughan, of St. Andrew's Church, assisted by Rev. Mr. Patterson and Rev. Dr. Dewart. On this occasion the members of our own Society and of the "Sons of Ireland" turned out in large numbers, and the collection taken up amounted to \$82.57

MEMBERSHIP ROLL.

The membership has been increased by the addition of 31 new members, and the names of 45 members have been struck off for various reasons, leaving the membership roll with a net loss of 14, the membership now standing at 302.

J. G. Hodgins, Esq., LL.D., was elected a life member.

During the year the Society suffered severe loss in the removal by death of several of its members, whose names will be found in the death roll. In the list is included the name of one of our Past Presidents, Mr. S. B. Windrum, who for many years took a very active part in the work of the Society.

CONCERT.

In the accounts you will notice a statement of the financial results of the concert held on the 30th March, 1897, which, as you will observe, added considerably to the funds of the Society.

ANNUAL DINNER.

The annual dinner was held in the Queen's Hotel on the 17th ultimo, and was perhaps the most successful function of the kind the Society has had in recent years. It is to be regretted that our esteemed President was not able to be present owing to his absence from the city. His health has been such that for some few months past he has not been able to take the active part in the work of the Society that he would have desired, and a few days prior to the date of the dinner he left for a trip to England. It is expected

that he will return some time during the summer, and we sincerely hope that it will be with health and vigor fully restored.

NEW ROOMS.

Special note should be taken of the fact that to-night we hold our first meeting in the new room which the Society has leased from the proprietors of the Arcade building. We trust that the decorations and furnishings will meet with your approval, and that this will prove an augury of the continued and increasing success of the work which the Society undertakes.

REPORT OF THE CHARITABLE COMMITTEE.

The Charitable Committee beg to report as follows:

Relief during the past year has been afforded to 367 families (including 434 children), and comprising in all 951 individuals, both residents and non-residents. Every case has been carefully investigated and substantial relief has been afforded to all who were found worthy.

The distribution consisted of the following items:

118 half-tons of coal,	33 nights' lodging,
30 half-cords of wood,	73 meals,
\$301.50 in groceries,	\$56.60 in cash,

CHRISTMAS DINNER DISTRIBUTION.

The Christmas distribution took place as usual on the 24th December, and some 190 families, comprising 750 individuals, were given a good substantial dinner, the total cost of the distribution amounting to \$270.57.

AMENDMENTS.

Constitution and By-Laws.

ART. 6.—Officers to be elected shall be nominated and seconded by members in good standing at the monthly meeting previous to the Annual General Meeting of the Society.—*October 6th, 1894.*

ART. 8.—All voting at any meeting shall be by open vote, except as hereinafter provided, or when five members desire the vote to be taken by ballot. The election of Officers and Council shall be by ballot, and shall take place at the Annual General Meeting of the Society, to be held in the City of Toronto on the second Friday in April in each year. All ballots to be deposited by voters in person. Candidates who secure a majority of votes cast shall be declared elected.—*November 2nd, 1894.*

BY-LAW No. 2.—All meetings of the Society shall be called by advertising in two or more of the Toronto daily newspapers, or by circular, or postal cards, or by any or all of these means, at the discretion of the President —*December 6th, 1895.*

ART. 5.—The Officers of this Society shall consist of a President, two Vice-Presidents, a Treasurer, a Secretary, and Chairman of the Charitable Committee, who, together with the Past President and fifteen ordinary or life members, shall constitute the Council—five of whom shall form a quorum for the transaction of business; none but ordinary or life members of the Society shall be eligible for office or entitled to vote at any meeting of the Society.—*April 15th, 1898.*
