B I L L .

An Act to separate the Townships of Upton and Acton from the County of Drummond, and to annex the said Townships to the County of St Hyacinthe, in the District of Montreal for Judicial and Municipal purposes.

**W**HEREAS the Townships of Upton and Acton, in the County of Drummond, in the District of Three Rivers, are much nearer to the County of St. Hyacinthe, and have much easier means of communication with the Town and County of St. Hyacinthe, than the Town of Three Rivers, and the chief place of the County of Drummond ; And whereas, a great number of the inhabitants of the said Townships have, by their petition, prayed to be annexed to, and included within the said County of St. Hyacinthe for Judicial and Municipal purposes ; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

10 That from and after the passing of this Act, the Townships of Upton and Acton, in the County of Drummond, in the District of Three Rivers, are and shall be annexed to and included within the County of St. Hyacinthe, in the District of Montreal, for Judicial, Municipal *and all other* purposes, as if the said Townships had always formed part of the County of St. Hyacinthe.

Preamble.

The said Townships detached from Drummond and annexed to St. Hyacinthe.
