

An Act to provide for the erection of certain new Counties and Townships in Upper Canada, and for certain purposes relative to such new Counties.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the esta- Preamble. blishment of certain new Counties in Upper Canada, to remain united to other Counties until they shall be disunited under the provisions of the Act passed in the 5 present Session, and intituled, " An Act for abolishing the County substiterritorial division of Upper Canada into Districts, and for this Session providing for temporary unions of Counties for judicial and cited. other purposes, and for the future dissolution of such unions as the increase of wealth and population may require:" Be 10 it therefore enacted, &c.
