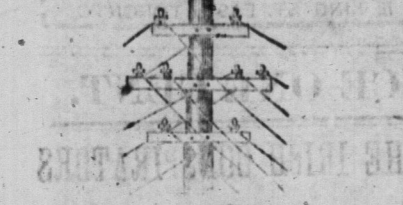

THE IMPERIAL CONFEDERATION HUMBLED

It is said that Sir Alexander Galt's remarks at Greenock lately, in favor of imperial federation, are not at all approved of by the Ottawa government.

The position which our country will hold in the history of the future will, in our judgment at least, depend far more on her achievements in the way of colonization, and on the diffusion of our race over the many of the choicest regions of the earth.

We fully recognize, and we duly value, the attachment of our colonial kinmen to the constitution under which we live, to the mother country from which we have sprung, and to the empire of which, though divided by distance, they continue to form an integral part.

It will be equally that of any minister who may hereafter stand in my place, to take care that the deep interest felt by the people of these islands in the welfare of the colonies shall find adequate expression in the language and in the action of the official representative of the crown.

The minister says that it will, in the future, be more England's concern to make great achievements in the way of filling up the colonies and extending them than the area of civilization and freedom, than in playing a part in Europe.

It will be of considerable interest to note the views of the English press generally with respect to this marked innovation on colonial office usage.
