

This is probably the most valuable contemporary record of the condition and progress of national literature, for the most important century of its existence, that any country possesses. No collection of English literature can be complete without it, and it claims additional interest for this country, from the complete view which it gives of the literature called forth by the heroic age of America—the Revolutionary struggle—a great portion of which has no other record, and is only known from its pages. Indeed it is the most complete history of English literature, and criticism ever offered for sale, containing the contributions of David Hume, Dr. Johnson, Smollett, Sterne, Goldsmith, etc., etc.

It was edited during the American Revolution by Dr. Edward Bancroft, whose sentiments and views were mainly American in tone. Some idea of its value may be gath red from the fact that Mr. Rich in his Bibliotheca Americana took hundreds of his titles from the work, and the criticisms he has appended are mainly from this source, where indeed they are often but not always acknowledged.




