## Most Gracious Sovericign,

WHEREAS by Message from His Excellency the Right Preamble. Honorable James, Earl of Elgin and Kincardine, Governor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over this Province of Canada, 5 bearing date the Eighth day of November, in the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-Two, and the Estimates accompanying the same, laid before both Houses of the Provincial Parliament, it appears that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Civil
10 Government of this Province for the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-Two, not otherwise provided for by law, and also for defraying the Cost of certain Public Buildings, and other pnrposes in the said Message and Estimates mentioned: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be
15 enacted, and Be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty; by and wirh the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assernbly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of 20 the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, An Act tc re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada, and it is hereby enacted by $£ 244,58815$ the authority of the same, That from and out of any unappropriated moneys forming part of the Consolidated Revenue
