An Act to amend Chapter Six of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada respecting Tavern Licenses.

W HEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of Montreal have experienced serious difficulties in performing the duty devolved upon them of considering and recommending the granting of licenses to hotels, taverns, temperance hotels, and other houses of public entertainment; and whereas it is expedient to amend chapter six of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, intituled "An Act respecting Tavern Keepers and the sale of intoxicating liquors," in so far as it relates to the City of Montreal:

Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the 10 Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The powers conferred on the Municipal Council of the City of Mon-Board established by sections nine, eleven and thirteen of the said Act, and which lished for approvide for the approval or disapproval of the certificate necessary for of certificates the obtaining of a license, shall hereafter be exercised by a Board com-

- 15 posed of the Mayor, the Recorder, and the Judge of the Sassions of the Peace of the said City; and it shall be the duty of the said board, to determine the persons whose certificates shall be confirmed and approved, and to require proof under oath (to be administered by any one of the Members of the said board) that the signatures attached to the said certificate are authentic and are the signatures of persons domiciled and inscribed as required by the said Act: Provided always, that the said Council shall retain the power of fixing and limiting the number of licenses which may be granted in each ward of the said City.
- 2. The form of confirmation and approval of the said certificate, at Form of apthe end of schedule B, annexed to the said Act shall be modified, in so proval of cerfar as it concerns the City of Montreal, so as to correspond with the tificates provisions of this Act, and such confirmation instead of being signed by the Mayor and Clerk of the said City, shall be signed by a majority of the Members of the Board.
- 30 3. Every petitioner shall be bound to present his papers and neces-proceedings sary certificate at the office of the Recorder's Court and at the same by petitioners time to deposit the sum of two dollars to defray the cost of the advertisement hereinafter mentioned and the other incidental expenses.

Security.

5. The security required by the fifteenth section of the said Act shall not hereafter be given in the presence of, or be approved by one or more Members of the said Council, but these formalities shall be observed before one or more members of the board established by this Act.

Repeal of inconsistent enactments. 6 Such portions only of the Act first above cited, as are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, are repealed in as far as they relate to the City of Montreal.

When this Act shall go nto force.

7. This Act shall come into force on the first day of January, 1864, and not before.
