An Act to revive and amend the Acts relative to the Grand Division and Subordinate Divisions of the Order of the Sons of Temperance in Canada West.

WHEREAS the Grand Division of the Sons of Temperance of Canada West has presented a Petition praying for the renewal and amendment of the statute relating to the said body, and it is expedient to grant the Prayer of the said Petition: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Preamble.

1. The Act passed in the Session held in the fourteenth and fifteenth years of Her Majesty's reign, intituled: "An Act to incorporate the Grand Division and Subordinate Divisions of the Order of the Sons of Temperance in Canada West," and the Act passed in the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled: "An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Order of the Sons of Temperance of Canada West," which owing to the premature termination of the now last Session of the Provincial Parliament were not continued beyond the end of that Session, shall be and are hereby revived, continued, and made permanent Acts and Laws, and shall be held to have been in force from the end of the said now last Session until the passing of this Act, subject always, from the passing of this Act, to the amendments hereinafter made.
2. Subordinate Divisions incorporated and to be incorporated under the said Acts or this Act, and the members thereof, shall henceforward be and become subject and amenable to the By-laws, Rules and Regulations of the Grand Division of the Order of the Sons of Temperance of Canada West, and shall have and exercise all their powers and privileges under the said Acts and this Act, subject to the said By-laws, Rules and Regulations, and not otherwise.
3. When any member is expelled or suspended by any Subordinate Division or by the Grand Division, or in case any member retires from such Subordinate Division, the said member shall cease to have any interest or claim whatever upon the funds or property of such Subordinate Division.
4. In case the Grand Division declares the Charter of a Subordinate Division forfeited pursuant to the By-laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Grand Division, such Subordinate Division shall stand dissolved.
5. The twelfth section of the Act first above cited and revived is hereby repealed.
6. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.

Acts 14, 15 V. c. 159, and 19, 20 V. c. 133, revived and made permanent.
