JUST as we go to press news comes over the wires that Hon. Mr. PATON, Secretary of State, was elected in West Huron, yesterday, defeating by a small majority Ananias Cameron, who carried the constituency last March, by 379 majority.

This weather the past few days has been exceedingly fine, and the snow is rapidly disappearing. The fact is, that while it is so warm, it is receiving a but shattering up; and should the mild spell continue much longer the ferry steamer will soon begin to ply again.

A special meeting of the new City Council was held Thursday evening. L. B. Miller and Robert Galbraith were appointed Auditors, and John Harper, B. O'Donnell and D. Small, Assessors for the next three years. The assessors will receive for their services, \$300 for the first year and \$150 for each of the two following years.

The Canadian government, it is stated, is very anxious to secure control of the entire telegraph system of the Dominion, and with this end in view, it is stated on high authority, at next session of parliament Premier Abbott will introduce a bill the main object of which will be the placing of the telegraph under direct control of the government the same as in Britain.

GLADSTONE is yet recovering on the continent and is now in the enjoyment of vigorous health, having entirely recovered from the effects of the attack of influenza from which he suffered in England. His son Herbert says he is in the habit of taking regular six mile walks, and that this pedestrian exercise seemingly excessive, does not seem to tire him in the least.

The Supreme Court met Friday. In the case of Mary McLeod vs. Kenneth McKenna and Donald McLeod—An action of trespass and assault—which was tried Trinity Term 1890, when a verdict for the plaintiff was returned, the Chief Justice gave judgment, discharging the rule nisi for a new trial. A. A. McLeod for plaintiff; L. H. Davies for defendant. The Court adjourned sine die.

The rise in the price of beef and mutton, caused by the war tariff, has led to an enormous demand for horseflesh in Paris. Over one third of the whole quantity of horseflesh consumed consists of slaughtered horses and mules. The price of horseflesh is retained at 10d. per pound. Worn out animals are rising in value, and are being bought up everywhere within a radius of 200 miles of the city.

FOR some time past letters and papers, many of the former containing money, mailed at and passing through the Amherst post-office have never reached their destination. An investigation into the matter has resulted in the arrest of a young man named Edward Handright, aged 18, who carried the mail between the office and station, and who confessed having at different times abstracted letters from the bags.

The Diamond Bookstore was entered and burglarized last Wednesday night, the burglar effecting an entrance through the front entrance. The cash drawer, which contained only a quantity of United States silver money, was rifled, and one of the show cases was pried open with a number of gold pens, lead pencils and some jewelry taken therefrom. The theft took place between 8 and 11 o'clock.

No foreign mail was received Wednesday last, the steamer being unable to leave Georgetown owing to the snow storm. Mails were regularly received the following day and Friday; but on Saturday another deadlock occurred and no mails have since been received. Possibly the delay will be on this evening. The delay is caused by an ice jam at the entrance to Pictou which prevents the steamer's return. The mail from the Island was landed on Monday.

An exhibition of a new process of cutting boards from the log was recently made at Green Point, L. I. The machine used 450 pounds. It is moved by a fly wheel weighing six tons. The entire plant weighs about forty tons. The logs cut were spruce, ash, birch, Spanish cedar, beech, and maple, and were sliced into half-inch planks at the rate of twenty-five minutes and dressed on both sides. The exhibition was a decided success and designed to revolutionize the lumber trade.

Hon. James Warburton passed away on Sunday evening at the advanced age of 82. Mr. Warburton was born at Garryhinch, Ireland, in 1810, and came to this Province twenty-four years later, locating at Lot 11. He was for many years a member of the House of Assembly, and also filled the offices of Treasurer and Colonial Secretary in the Administration led by Hon. George Coles. Mr. Warburton retired from active politics in 1868, and five years later removed to this city, where he has since resided.

MR. GILLIS, of Indian River, delivered his most interesting lecture on Canada, before a very large audience in the Catholic Institute at Lunenburg on Wednesday evening last. His discourse, which lasted an hour and a half, was replete with interest and information. After fully impressing his hearers with the great capabilities of this Canada of ours, he gave to the young men in the audience the practical advice, that if necessity should ever require them to emigrate from the Island, they should be sure to settle in this great Dominion, where great advantages are offered them and where they will not lose their nationality. Two things necessary for success in those emigrating to the North-West or elsewhere he strongly urged, viz: a good education and temperate habits. Several clergymen and other gentlemen made witty and eloquent addresses at the close of the lecture.
