A PERSECUTED FARMER.

Baron Burned Down and Fruit Trees Destroyed—Two Neighbors Arrested on Suspicion.

Hamilton, Oct. 2.—Mr. J. Armstrong, who lives with his wife and family on 20, concession 3, township of Grimsby, Lincoln county, has been the victim of a systematic and mysterious course of persecution.

On the night of Sept. 29 one of his huggies was destroyed and another badly holed, and fifty fruit trees in his orchard cut, girdled or barked, the result being that many of them died.

On August 8 an anonymous letter came to him in a morning envelope, post-marked Hamilton, and was addressed to the writer as the proprietor of the farm.

Three to four inches of snow are reported to have fallen in New Hampshire, Vermont yesterday afternoon. At St. Johnsbury the weight of the snow damaged apple trees and telegraph wires.

The Western Union telegraph secured a verdict in its favor in the Hatch-William case, involving over \$15,000,000 of stock. All obstacles in the way of paying dividends, it is believed, have been removed.

The projected drought in New Orleans has caused a water famine, and there is a bitter feeling against the waterworks company for not providing for the emergency.

Before the senate committee yesterday Alfred Cohen, San Francisco, said there was a scarcity of laborers for the Pacific coast since the shutting off of Chinese immigration. He thought the fare through to be reduced.

There was a bitter fight at the polls at Lakeside, Conn., between Catholics and Protestants. The Catholics were victorious.

Loss from E. S. Tariff Revision. WASHINGTON, Oct. 2.—The new tariff law has been in operation three months, during which the customs receipts show a falling off of \$9,447,000; internal taxes, \$3,337,000; and miscellaneous receipts \$2,200,000. At this rate the decrease in the annual revenue will be \$78,000,000.

Another British Consul Fired At. CONSTANTINOPLE, Oct. 2.—The British consul at Soutira, Albania, was fired at while hunting recently, but not hurt. The assassin escaped.

Russian Dictatorship. ST. PETERSBURG, Oct. 2.—It is decided that Russia is making military preparations on the Austrian and German frontiers.

Si-Ming Killed. LEIGH, ENG., Oct. 2.—An oge was being hoisted in the Nelson coal pit today the rope broke and six miners were killed.

Great Damage to Shipping. PHILADELPHIA, Oct. 2.—The schooner Edward Blake arrived from St. Pierre, Martinique, reports that all the shipping in the harbor was destroyed by a hurricane on Sept. 4. Many lives were lost. The damage to vessels and cargoes was two million dollars.

September Lumber Shipments. DETROIT, Oct. 2.—The lumber shipments by the lake during September were 29,641,000 feet from East Saginaw, and 73,870,000 feet from Bay City. East Saginaw shipped 1,709,000 shingles and Bay City 18,537,000. Total lumber shipments from Saginaw river were 597,149,947 feet against 556,558,846 feet for the corresponding period of last year.
