# REPORT.

The General Missionary Committee

To the Friends and Supporters of the Canadian Primitive Methodist Missions.

The flight of time renders it necessary to present you again with our Report, and that flight cannot fail to remind contemplative minds how much nearer we are to eternity than twelve months ago. We have not so much time for usefulness as we had. Our opportunities for doing good are less than they were. Whatsoever, therefore, our hands findeth to do, we should do at once : while the day lasts, we should work; for the night cometh, when no man can work. "Occupy till I come," is the command given to all the followers of Christ; a command involving present, continual labour. The condition of the world calls for our labours: notwithstanding the existence of our holy Christianity, how alarmingly fearful is that condition! A Report confined within narrow limits, cannot enter into details; but we have only to look abroad to find that the world still lieth in the arms of the wicked one. At the time of this Report being written, nations boasting of their advanced civilization are grappling with each other in iron fight: the earth is deluged with the blood of thousands of men: widows are numbered by thousands, and the fatherless by tens of thousands. The Man of Sin has been adding to his other blasphemies, by pronouncing himself infallible. The spirit of indifferentism is rampant; scepticism yet lifts its brazen front to the heavens: iniquity unblushingly presents itself in most enticing forms; and yet, in the midst of all these, there are encouragements for the Christian to toil on. In many parts of the earth, the gospel is winning its widening way. In India, hoary superstitions are giving way before it; and a spirit of enquiry respecting its character and claims has been extensively evoked. Madagascar having renounced idolatry, claims to be ranked at least amongst nominal Christian nations. China and Japan, notwithstanding their opposition, are being silently influenced by the religion of Jesus. Spain has proclaimed liberty of conscience and worship; and Austria has abolished the Concordat. Christian Churches are feeling more deeply their responsibility, and are doing more for Jesus than heretofore: larger gifts are laid on the Missionary altar than in former days; and godly people are more cheerfully acknowledging their gold and silver belongeth to the Lord.

The Parent Society of the Church with which we are connected has during the year opened a Mission to Africa, and two brethren have been labouring there with success: a third is preparing to go to another part of that Continent: and here, in this land, God has been blessing our labours. Our discouragements are many; yet God is our helper. Our difficulties, principally arising from a scarcity of efficient and experienced labourers, are neither few nor unimportant. To have responded to the calls for assistance at the last

oronto, on 170, Thursonaries are e Secretary d until the sted to give ssions, that Conference, fifteen additional labourers were required; but we had them not. For want of proper help, one Station (Park Hill) had to be given up: the appointments forming it were given to Bosanquet and Macgillivray Circuits. We are pleased to say that the members of the Gore Street Church in Hamilton, though few in number, nobly resolved to occupy their old place on the list of Circuits; and the Conference, fully sympathising with them, gave them a little assistance, and made them a Circuit.

Our financial position, though not yet all we can desire it to be, is in advance of last year. The income from our own Circuits and Missions is \$7,517 41. The English Grant of \$2,000 00, and the balance of last year, make altogether \$13,191 52. Our expenditure has been \$9,798 66; leaving a balance of \$3,393 86, which balance is, however, already appropriated, within a trifle. An examination of the balance sheet will show that our expenditure is increasing; and this must be so, if we would enlarge our borders at all. On the increase of our Missionary revenue depends in great measure our extension as a people. It must not be lost sight of, that just in proportion as our Missionary Fund enlarges, so can we take up new ground. Our increase for the last year is about \$250 00. Eighteen Stations report a decrease in all of about \$425 00. Last year we asked for \$8,000 00, and stated that that sum would only be an increase of \$727 00 on the previous year. Had these eighteen Stations raised as much as they did the previous year, we should have had, within a few dollars, the sum we asked for. We ask for it again this year. Brethren, as far as money is concerned, let our object be to raise \$8,000 00 this year. It is a sum that can be raised. Let the defaulting Stations come up to their position of 1868-9; and let the Stations that last year increased their revenue, do the same this year; and the amount will be raised. Now Ministers, Collectors, Schools, Members, and Friends go heartily to work. Let all do what they can: let all give as God hath prospered them; and we shall have more than we ask for this year. Then we can respond to the many calls frequently uttered for help; and then we can rejoice in the belief, that having helped ourselves, God, even our God will help us, and cause the light of His countenance to shine upon us.

#### BRANT MISSION.

During the year there has been a very large amount of labour accomplished by your missionaries. Twenty souls have been brought to God, and have united with our society. We have secured to the Connexion the best building site in the village of Walkerton for church purposes, and we have it paid for. We have also secured land in the village of Clifford, on which to build a church. Our financial income is greatly in advance of last year; and all demands will be nearly met. We have preached 340 sermons; conducted by five field meetings; and spent 21 weeks in special efforts. I have visited 967 families during the year, and my colleague has visited more than 15 families weekly; we have led class 208 times; led 456 prayer meetings; addressed Sabbath schools; held temperance meetings; and travelled more than 4000 miles. We have peace in all our societies, and are praying for enlarged prosperity, to more than make up for 41 removals during the past two years.

#### BRANTFORD MISSION.

During the past year our little Zion has met with many discouragementsi; some have removed from us, and we have lost their fellowship and sucportt; others have yielded to the cunning craftiness of designing men, who trust in themselves that they are righteous, and despise others, taking the way of heaven of "free seats and no collection;" while others have forsaken Christ for the sinful pleasures of this present world. Notwithstanding this, we have a few names in Brantford who have stood by us, and laboured and waited till the Lord came to our help. Although the year has not been crowned with that amount of success in soul-saving we earnestly desired, yet we have not laboured in vain; some of the seed sown has sprung up, and is now blooming in the Lord's vineyard, beneath the invigorating rays of the Sun of Righteousness, and we trust ere long will be gathered in as golden sheaves to the garner of the Lord. We have a flourishing Sabbath school, and a number of the scholars have been recently converted, and promise fair to be devoted Christians. Our finances are in advance of last year; and considering the circumstances of our people, and their church debts, they do well in supporting your missionary. May the Lord come to his holy temple, and manifest his glory T. GRIFFITH. and power in saving souls.

#### CARADOC MISSION.

Considerable labour has been spent this year by your missionary, in travelling, preaching, and visiting; and not altogether in vain. During our special services the Lord was pleased to visit us with his grace, and nine precious souls have united with us in church fellowship. The ordinary annual income is a little in advance of last year; but our missionary income is a few dollars less than previous year. We have six preaching places connected with our work, and the congregations are good at each place. We have peace and harmony within our borders; and have realized financially, during the year, the sum of \$421 00. To be more useful in the conversion of precious and immortal souls, is the earnest desire of the writer.

#### COLLINSBY MISSION.

To the success of the work on this station there are several drawbacks; first, want of room to extend within reasonable bounds. 2nd. Want of a true Christian spirit among its members. 3rd. Want of liberality to the extent of their means. In the sight of God we can say that through the past year we have toiled hard for success, but as yet with small results. We have held two protracted meetings, and would have held another had not the roads become blocked up with snow. Souls were brought to the Lord at both meetings, but owing to the loss sustained by removals, deaths, left, and fallen, numbering in all fifteen, we report a decrease of six. In money matters we should have reported a larger revenue had it not been for our parsonage debt, together with the debt on Elginburg Church, towards the liquidation of which a considerable sum has been realized the present year. In connection with our ordinary services, we have succeeded admirably in the holding of three Bible classes weekly, numbering about 70, between the ages of 16 and 70 respectively. Some of these are members of our church, whilst the greater part are members of the congregation. Cheering are the results already, for which we thank God, and R. PATTISON. take courage.

#### CHATHAM MISSION.

In this part of the Lord's vineyard we have this year laboured under much difficulty, from a variety of causes; but by God's help your missionary has faithfully striven to do his duty. The uncommonly open winter, with roads extremely bad, has prevented to a considerable extent the success of revival

The resignation of my colleague in the middle of the year, militated seriously against the advancement of the work. We have seven appointments, stretching over a wide tract of country, and the roads at some seasons of the year are impassable. About thirteen weeks have been spent in protracted meetings, resulting in the conversion of a good number of souls. Our missionary meetings were quite successful, so that we report an increase in that fund. We have also an increase in ordinary income, in Sabbath school teachers and scholars, and in finances generally. We have made arrangements for paying off the \$800 00 debt on Chatham church, and for building two large sheds. Spiritually the mission is progressing, and we hope the Lord will soon give us a rich harvest of precious souls.

#### GUELPH MISSION.

In taking a retrospective glance of the past, we have much cause for gratitude to God for his gracious visitations and abundant mercy toward us on this station. Our work in Guelph is considerably circumscribed, and our opportunities for extension are comparatively limited. We have had to endure the drawbacks of removals, defections, and inability to meet the demands of our pecuniary liabilities; still, notwithstanding many disadvantages, we have made some progress. We have held protracted meetings during thirteen weeks, and received eighteen into membership; and the missionary fund has been considerably advanced. At our Beech Grove appointment a large bible class has been organized in connection with the Sabbath school, and funds have been raised to purchase a library of 170 volumes. Under the superintendency of the energetic gentleman who is now at its head, the school may yet become a power for good in the neighbourhood. We are thankful for the many blessings bestowed, and pray that the Lord would pour out his Spirit upon all the churches.

#### HAMILTON MISSION.

The year opened under somewhat trying circumstances; a heavy church debt threatening the existence of the church, and a lack of unity in the membership. I feel grateful to have to say that we have in some measure overcome these evils, first, by a large reduction in church debt; and, 2nd, in the existence of a better feeling in the church. Considerable portion of my time during the year was occupied in soliciting donations for the Gore Street Church; I was not able, therefore, to give that attention to pastoral and other duties which I desired; and though not able to report numerical progress, the property is saved to the connexion. During the last three months, I have worked very hard—never harder—in pastoral work and revival services: in the same time I have visited three hundred families, and with good results. A few have been added to the church; our congregations are improving a little; and the official brethren speak hopefully of the prosperity of the cause. WALTER REID.

#### HAWKSVILLE MISSION.

In reviewing the past year, we are thankful we have not laboured in vain, though our expectations have not been fully realized. Soon after last Conference we held special services at our appointment, and at the fall we resumed these services in the same place, at which we hope good was done; and we have held special services at two other places, one of which was cheeringly successful, and at the other some were again restored to the church. We have held two field meetings, and several temperance meetings. Our missionary meetings were not as successful as we could have wished, on account of the very stormy weather, and from the failure of the crops this year and last. Our Hawksville church debt has been considerably reduced, and we hope will soon be swept away altogether. Our parsonage has had extensive repairs, and is now comfortable; we have paid off the balance of the old debt, and some part

#### JUBILEE MISSION.

Your missionaries have laboured hard on this field during the past few months, to push on the good work of God. Thank God, we have not laboured in vain; a number of precious souls have been saved, and many added to the church. We report an increase of twenty-six for the year, after filling up deficiencies to the number of thirty-four, caused by removals, &c.; and we are still expecting greater success. We are happy to say we have peace and prosperity throughout our beloved Zion: our finances are considerably in advance of last year. We believe that this Station, with the blessing of God on patient and earnest labour, will ere long be self-sustaining. May the good Lord prosper his work on this station more and more.

#### KINCARDINE MISSION.

Though the post has been a year of labour and toil, yet we have cause for thankfulness that we have not laboured in vain in the Lord. After filling up vacancies by removals, death, and fallen, we are able to report an increase of sixteen members. We have travelled several thousand miles; held three protracted meetings; visited 995 families; and preached 206 sermons. We have bought the Lawson property in Bervie, consisting of a house and four town lots. The house is 28 by 38, and when altered and repaired will make a good church. We have taken up one new appointment at Pine River, and could take up others if we could attend to them; but the station is already too large for one minister to work.

#### LONDON MISSION.

In reviewing the past year's efforts on this Station, we may state that we have labored hard in the various departments of the Church's field of operations, and with some success: the appointments have been properly kept up, with an increase of congregations. A small debt upon one of the churches has been paid, and a good fence has been erected around another. The Sabbath Schools have shared in our labor, with a little improvement, King Street School having purchased a cabinet organ. Many of our people have risen up into a higher life, and with this increase of spirituality, we have an enlarged liberality. In the latter the people of London are not behind. Your missionaries have done a good deal of visiting, not only amongst the members of society, but others have shared largely in this labor, including the hospital and jail. Yet, amid all this toil, our increase is but small, being only 9, after filling up 28 In the regular ordinary income we have an advance of \$134; we also raised \$163 by extra efforts; but even then your laborers are \$93 deficient on the year. Our contributions to the mission fund, we regret to say, are less by \$19 that last year. The collectors were late in the field, and in order not to clash with church anniversaries the meetings were held late in the season, J. H. ACKHAM. which may partly account for the deficiency.

#### MINTO MISSION.

On entering the Station, we found what had up to the preceding year been one of the largest and best societies on the mission in a most deplorable condition; and through the opposition of some, they still remain low, several having withdrawn, causing a serious loss to our church funds. Owing to the great failure of the crops last harvest, the people have had hard to struggle in this settlement, and some have had to dispose of their farms at a great sacrifice. The large extent of this mission, and the inability of most of the local preach-

ers through infirmity and other causes to sustain the appointments, greatly militates against its prosperity. Some of our most efficient and zealous preachers are frequently from twenty to twenty-eight miles from home at their Sabevening appointments. However, we feel much pleasure in saying, that through the gracious and at times special manner in which the Almighty sustained and guided us through the perplexities and conflicts of the past year, some little prosperity has been secured. Three Sabbath Schools, organized during the year, are in a prosperous state. One of the best churches to be found on the missions has been completed, and left in easy circumstances; and two three of the societies have struggled nobly to be in advance of last year in contributing to the church funds. To ensure future success, we would strongly urge a divison the church funds. of this station. Listowel might be made the head of the south half, including Bethel, Tindell's, Bristow's, and if agreeable the extreme westerly appointment of Peel station. Harriston, which has every prospect of becoming a railway station of considerable importance, might be made the head of the north half of Minto station, and might have attached to it the three extreme easterly appointments of Brant station, which would make it a compact station, embracing eight appointments, in a radius of ten miles, and could be worked by a married preacher, with every prospect of success. To work these large missions is a waste of time, an abuse of health, and much bodily wear and tear. We think they might be remodeled, so as to be worked far more efficiently, and with much less waste of time and physical energy. W. MONKMAN.

#### MUSKOKA MISSION.

When I commenced this my second year on the Muskoka mission, we had a total of forty-five members, being forced the previous year to report seven of a decrease; but with the blessing of God on our labours, we have kept steadily increasing this year, and at its close we are able to report sixty-nine members, being an increase for this year of twenty-five To God be all the praise and glory. Besides, one of our local preachers has been filling an appointment in Macaulay, and has formed a class of seven or eight members, who would unite with us, provided we could supply them with regular services; and at Lake Rosseau there is also a small class, that would unite with us on similar conditions. From other places the Macedonian cry is heard, "come over and help us." This mission extends over a large area, comprising parts of the six townships of Muskoka, Draper, Macaulay, Monck, Stephenson, and Watt; and owing to the scattered state of the population, the labours of the minister are extensive, and often very trying. We have held two protracted services this winter; one of about five wteks duration at Ebenezer, at which six precious souls passed from darkness into light; the other at Three Mile Lake, which continued over five weeks, with good results.

#### NAPANEE MISSION.

During the past year your missionary has laboured harder for the prosperity of God's cause than he ever did in any one year since he entered the ministry. #### PARIS MISSION.

We have found this station to be a very hard field of labour, with but few green spots of encouragement. With united effort, and careful management, this mission may soon rise in usefulness, and take a prominent place among some of your best stations.

#### PORTLAND MISSION.

#### ROSE MOUNT MISSION.

In preparing this report, we may justly say the Lord has been graciously with us on this Station, and we trust some permanent good has been done. Your missionary has travelled over 3000 miles; preached 380 sermons; made several hundred visits; led class seventy times, and much of the Divine presence has been realized. Two new churches have been built, and arrangements made for another to go up this summer. Said churches and land have cost \$1150 00, towards which we have raised this year \$550 00; and \$82 54 has been raised for a shed and fence for Rose Mount church. The missionary money has been brought up, and the ordinary revenue raised to \$165 83; making a total of over \$800 00 this year. We have twenty-seven subscribers for our magazines, and nine for the Christian Jourual, and have sold over \$90 00 worth of connexional publications. We have held 13 weeks of special services; and after

#### STRATFORD AND MITCHELL MISSION.

Notwithstanding the many disadvantageous circumstances under which this station has laboured during the year, we are happy to say that it is in some measure prospering. We have five appointments; and we have connexional churches valued at about \$2300 00; on three of which there is a debt of \$350. The sum of \$150 has been raised during the year for church purposes, \$70 of which has been laid out in painting and repairing Stratford church. Although we have lost 30 members through removals, etc, yet, praise the Lord, our membership is a little in advance of last year; our missionary money is \$7 24 increase; and the ordinary income about the same as heretofore. Your missionaries have laboured hard during the past year: owing to the union of these two stations, the work is most laborious. The writer has driven on ministerial duty about 5000 miles; attended 14 missionary meetings; eight socials for the church; four temperance meetings; been engaged, in connection with his colleagues, in twelve weeks of protracted meetings; and, besides other pastoral duties, preached every Sabbath since last Conference-neither rain, wind, storm, or cold preventing me from being at my post, though our station at present is about thirty miles in length. Bro. Gifford, who was with me about two quarters, and Bro. Haylock, who has been with me about eight weeks, deserve great credit for the zeal they have manifested in the cause of Christ. Brother Gifford succeeded well, and was instrumental in the salvation of souls. Bro. Haylock, not having a horse, is giving his attention chiefly to the Mitchell end of the mission; he is working hard, and is well received. May the Lord succeed WM. CLOWES JOLLEY. the labour of his servants, and revive his work.

#### WALPOLE MISSION.

On our arrival on this station we found it in a low state; but we visited the people, and preached, and in other respects laboured zealously amongst them. We found favor with the people, and have made a little progress. We held two field meetings, which were well attended, and we hope good was done; we held a protracted meeting in Rainham, and enlarged the class from seven to over twenty, which has given us great encouragement; we also set about a new church, and got subscriptions for that purpose to the amount of \$240.00; and also secured a half-acre of land on which to build; and as most of the lumber is on the ground, we expect to see it finished in a few months. We also held a protracted meeting at Selkirk, when three were converted, two of whom joined with us. After making up losses of fallen, death, left, and removals, we have nine of an increase. Our missionary money last year was \$76.00; this year it amounts to \$95.40. To the Lord be all the praise.
