LIVE STOCK INDUSTRY OF CANADA LIVE SIUGA INDUDINI OF LAIMAA Last February there were brought to-gether at Ottawa from the various prov-inces upwards of one hundred men official-ly delegated to represent forty-four live stock and record associations, besides a large number of interested persons to com-sider and discuss the various features of the live stock industry. This gathering which constituted the third general con-vention of the National Live Stock As-sociation spent two days each of three busy sessions upon its programme which incluuded reviews of the conditions of the live stock industry prevailing in the re-spective provinces, interprovincial trade in pure bred live stock, the beef cattle in-dustry in the east and west, the dairy cat-tle industry, the development of the sheep and swine industries, the market for canadian horses, transportation of live stock, stallion legislation, the childe meat-ress. 



 


