FIFTY-NINTH ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT
OF THE
ST. GEORGE'S SOCIETY
OF TORONTO,
FOR THE YEAR 1893.

The year for which the officers of the Society were elected having expired, it becomes the duty of the Committee to present this their Annual Report.

The past year, with the exception of the severity of the weather at its commencement, has not been marked by anything of an unusual character. There were comparatively but few arrivals of English Emigrants during the summer, and so far as the Society's finances were concerned it was fortunate that such was the case, for the winter's relief had reduced them to a low condition.

RECEIPTS.

The total receipts, from all sources, including the balance of \$733.75 from last year, has been \$3,890.57. At the beginning of the year, the sum of \$570 was invested, being

somewhat in excess of the amount of the Life Membership fees actually in hand for that purpose. Some few cases have again occurred of parties returning the amounts they had received from the Society. And it is satisfactory to know that the financial position of the Society is good, the accounts being well paid up.

RELIEF.

During the year 1,225 applications for relief of various kinds, such as pecuniary aid, provisions, railway or other passages, etc., were received, and the requirements granted; and a variety of services rendered, involving much time and attention, and in which altogether the sum of \$928.89 was expended. Orders for twelve graves for adults and five for children have been given in our lots in St. James' Cemetery, which are getting nearly occupied. The scarcity of employment is at the present time, and has been for some time past, severely felt in Toronto as well as elsewhere, and has caused a very great demand for relief. At the same time, the mildness so far of the present winter is modifying the sufferings of the needy.

FINANCIAL.

The Treasurer's Statement shows that the financial position of the Society is satisfactory.

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COMMITTEE'S REPORT.

MEMBERSHIP.

There have been fourteen Life Members and eighty-two Ordinary Members elected during the year. The numbers at the present time are: Honorary Life Members, 11; Life Members, 415; Ordinary Members, 702; making a total of 1,128.

So far as is known, nine Life Members have died during the year, viz:—Mr. G. L. Beardmore, a gentleman of the highest standing in Toronto, socially and commercially; Mr. Richard Caddick, one of the foremost members of the Sons of England Benevolent Society, and a generous contributor to our Society; Mr. G. F. Dawson, a gentleman of high position in Washington, U. S.; Mr. G. Goulding, also of good reputation in Toronto, socially and commercially; Mr. Lewis Moffatt, of the same character; Mr. Herbert Mortimer, a former Secretary of the Society, who rendered the most valuable and unrequited services to it in its earlier days and who was a most estimable gentleman; Mr. Richard Snelling a Barrister of good standing in Toronto; Mr. F. Wright, a Past President of the Society, who for several years took an active interest in its welfare; Mr. John Crickmore, also a Past President and a very estimable gentleman.

Of the Ordinary Members, six have died, viz: Mr. Wm. Elliot, the father of Past President R. W. Elliot, a gentleman of the most amiable character and of high commercial reputation; Mr. Newton Kent, a young and rising Barrister; Mr. J. H. Pearce, a gentleman of good commercial standing; Mr. Wm. Pullen, a recently elected member; Mr. E. M.

Shetton, a member for many years and an earnest supporter of the Society; Mr. C. Fuller, late of the Copp, Clark Company, also who had been a member for many years.

ANNIVERSARIES, ENTERTAINMENTS, ETC.

As from the establishment of the Society, the first Anniversary Service was held in St. James' Cathedral, on Sunday afternoon, April 23rd, St. George's Day. The Rev. Dr. Mockridge preached a good practical sermon on the occasion. His Lordship the Bishop, the Rector Canon Du Moulin, the Curate and other Ministers being present.

As on previous occasions, our Brethren, the Sons of England, joined us in goodly numbers and the Church was well filled.

The second service was held in St. George's Hall on the afternoon of Sunday, October 15th. A good, instructive sermon was preached by the Rev. S. Nicholls, a Congregational Minister.

The musical portions of the services, which were very efficient, were conducted by Mr. E. W. Schuch in St. James' Cathedral, and by Mr. H. M. Blight in the Hall.

The collections were, considering the dulness of trade, as much as might be expected. The St. James' Cathedral was very kindly and courteously granted.

SMOKING CONCERT.

On the 28th of February, a Smoking Concert was given by the Society in the Hall, which was well attended, and much enjoyed, producing a fair return, and the repetition of a similar entertainment would probably meet with even better success.

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COMMITTEE'S REPORT.

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ANNUAL DINNER.

On Monday evening, April 24th, the Annual Dinner was held in the Hall. A very pleasant and agreeable evening was spent; about one hundred gentlemen sat down, the President occupying the chair. It being the first time of our having the Dinner in our own Hall, it was an event well worthy of remembrance. The conveniences and accommodation were ample.

PICNIC.

The annual Picnic was again held at Victoria Park on the 2nd of August. The attendance was good, the weather was fine, there were a variety of amusements, and altogether a most delightful day was spent.

CONCERT IN THE PAVILION.

On the evening of the 28th of November, a Concert was given in the Pavilion, Horticultural Gardens. Mr. E. W. Schuch very generously undertook to get up and conduct it gratuitously, and a number of ladies and gentlemen voluntarily took part in it. There was a very fair attendance, and the results were an acceptable addition to the funds of the Society.

CHRISTMAS DISTRIBUTION.

The usual Christmas distribution to the English poor was again made on Saturday, December 23rd. It took place in our own Building, and was conducted with order and regularity. As before, the applicants were received in the Hall and passed in rotation down to the supper-room and out at the front door. The Collections by the Committee and Stewards amounted to \$937.75 and the expenditure to \$844.73.

Eight hundred and ninety two families, consisting of four thousand three hundred and fifty-eight individuals, received a supply of provisions.

There were purchased nine thousand pounds of beef, fifteen hundred loaves of bread, nine hundred pounds of sugar and two hundred and twenty-five pounds of tea, and some sweetmeats; sundry other things were presented; thus giving a supply to many who were not otherwise provided.

CONCLUSION.

In conclusion, the Committee would recommend the claims of the Society as worthy of support, upon the English portion of the community. There are many now in Canada in good circumstances who owe their start on the road of prosperity to a St. George's Society.
