An Act to authorize a Verification Survey of the line between the fourth and fifth Ranges of the Township of Chatham.

WHEREAS great loss and inconvenience has been sustained by divers occupants of land, residing on the fourth and fifth Ranges of the Township of Chatham, County of Argenteuil, in consequence of a second survey made of the said lines, under instructions addressed by the Government to T. Z. Watson, to sub-divide part of the said Township, which has created disputes: The said occupant claiming that the original survey, by Samuel Holland, Surveyor General, of the 27th August, 1798, is the correct boundary line of their lands: Therefore, in order to terminate such disputes, and declare the true boundary of the lands, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. A Verification Survey of the Concession line between the fourth and fifth Ranges of the said Township of Chatham be forthwith made, under the direction of the Commissioner of Crown Lands.

II. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
