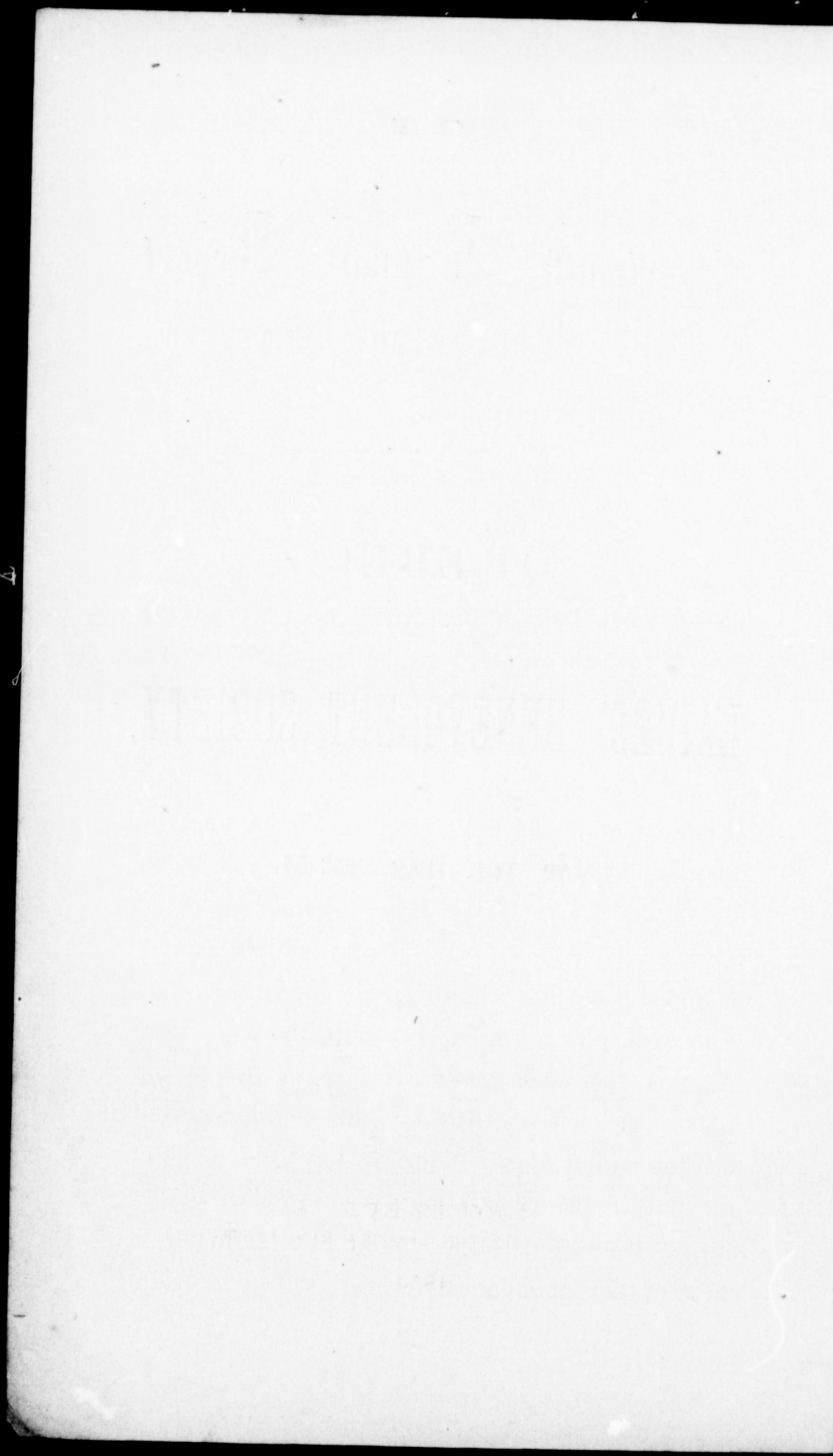

Ladies' Benevolent Society.

Instituted October 29th, 1838.

THE Quebec Ladies' Benevolent Society, having passed through another year of its useful though unostentatious labor of love, it now becomes the duty of the Committee to lay before its patrons and the public an account of the state of the funds, and of the operations for the past year. Owing to the lateness of the season, at which the collectors went round, there were fewer subscriptions than usual taken up in one of the wards, but it may reasonably be hoped that those who were not called upon last year, will subscribe more cheerfully and more liberally this, that such a useful society may not be too much restricted in affording relief to the poor and destitute among us. While we have the words of our Lord, "The poor ye have always with you," he has left it as a duty on his followers to minister to them of their abundance.

This Society has been in existence for sixteen years, and during that period, the widow and the orphan, the aged and the stranger have been benefited by the timely relief which it has afforded. Were the public more generally aware how much good may be done by a small amount from each when placed in the hands of such a society as this, there would be found very few who would refuse to contribute, however small their donation might be. A more lengthened appeal is unnecessary, as the objects and working of this society are too well known to require further explanation.
