Members or subscribers are not allowed to take out more than one volume at a time, except upon payment of 5 cents for each week for every additional volume.

Any member or subscriber who retains a volume for a longer period than specified therein, without being renewed, shall pay a fine of five cents for every week or part of a week it may be so retained.

If a book be lost, written in or otherwise damaged, the member or subscriber in whose name it was taken out shall pay the amount of damages, the value of the book or set, or replace it by one equally good, and shall not be entitled to any privilege from the Library until such loss or damage is paid.

All books must be returned to the Library by the second Tuesday in April in each year, so as to enable the Library Committee to report upon the state of the Library, and any member or subscriber violating this rule shall pay a fine of 25 cents.

Members and subscribers are prohibited from lending books or exchanging them with others.

Particular attention is directed to the rules and regulation for the Library and Reading Room.
