LONDON, Aug. 14.—It is understood that the cabinet council yesterday decided practically to insist on the land bill as finally passed by the house of commons, and in the event of the lords refusing to pass it, parliament will be summoned again in November, when the bill will be introduced. But there is no disposition to force on the house of lords a bill more radical than that presented to them. There is a disposition in Conservative circles to suggest a compromise, the substance of which is to effect that the privilege to leasehold of ranking as present tenants at the expiration of their lease shall be confined to those whose lease expires within the next fifteen years.

THE STANDARD SAYS: We are in a position to state that no solution of the land problem has been arrived at. Well-informed persons, however, know the cabinet's position, and it has been made to appear, and we advise the public to be reassured. There are no materials for a compromise, though a little time may be needed before negotiations for a compromise are arranged.
