The Huronian take has been ghandoned for the present, owing to the difficulties of transportation. It was impossible to work a low grade ore at a profit when transportation cost \$70 a ton instead of \$4. In rough mining countries transportation is the greatest difficulty. Of course every mine cannot have a syntch to it; but the construction of a railway would soon attract traversing roads which municipalities or individuals would build. The Dominion Government has granted aid to the extent of \$3200 to a railway which is in course of construction through what is at present the best mining region, from Port Arthur to continent with an American road at the boundary. Considerable progress has been made towards the completion of arrangements for its consistruction; but it is extremely difficult to raise any money on bonds on which alone, miless sufficient aid is given, such roads can be built. They are in fact colonization roads, and the province is more certain of being benefited by their construction than the promoters. In 1877 the Ontario Government, in the Railways as colonization roads, and provided for their being built from land appropriations in the districts traversed whenever the Legislature thought proper to subsidize them. The land was not to be given to the companies whatever aim per mile the Legislature authorized in each particular case. In this way the Government retained its control over the lands and would not be obliged to pay over any money maless it was forthooming from land sales.

If the Legislature is not prepared to make a money grant it can safely adopt this course without involving the province in any expense; and such a system of aid would be of great service to colonization railways.




