GENERAL RULES!

1. Cheerful obedience at all times.
2. Strict order must be maintained.
3. All must strive to learn the **ENGLISH LANGUAGE** as quickly as possible; only English will be allowed during meals and sewing school. Girls must speak up, and answer promptly.
4. All doors must be shut quietly.
5. No girl can carry matches: or touch the lamps when lighted.
6. No girl can go into the town without leave.
7. No one can go to the spring for water after tea.
8. Slop-pails must not be allowed to overflow.
9. No talking allowed, in bed.
10. There must be no talking, or looking round in church

SPECIAL RULES.

COOKS.

1. Cooks must get up when the first bell is rung in the morning.
2. The water must be changed on the salt fish without fail every morning after breakfast.
3. Bread must be set on Monday and Thursday in the afternoon before tea; and put in tins ready for the oven on Tuesday and Friday before breakfast
4. Pancakes must be set on Wednesday morning before breakfast.
5. The head-cook will be responsible for all the dishes.
6. Cooks must see that the wood-box and water pails are kept filled.

SEWING ROOM GIRL.

1. Sweep the room three times a day.
2. Keep up the fires.
3. See all shawls are hung upon right pegs.

BEDROOM GIRLS.

1. Rooms must be swept with the doors shut.
2. Bedroom girls will sweep the hall and porch also the stairs every day.

SCHOOLROOM.

1. School books and slates must be kept in proper places.
 2. Girls must go into school when the second bell begins to ring.
