Rev. C. S. Eby Writes an Open Letter to His Worship the Mayor and Citizens of Toronto.

BRIEF HISTORY OF THE MOVEMENT.

Sanitarium at Gravenhurst Has Done Nothing for the Poor of Toronto.

Open Letter to His Worship the Mayor and the Citizens of Toronto.

On the 10th inst., Mr. W. J. Gage, treasurer of the National Sanitarium Association wrote a letter to the Mayor of this city, which has been called by the press and city fathers, and which is published in the Globe.

Now that the burrah has subsided, let us look at that letter. There is nothing so new in it in the shape of an offer, or a promise—nothing to blind Mr. Gage or his associates to do anything whatever; and, judging from the past four years of similar statements from the same source, if the memory of the public were not so short, they would at least hesitate and demand something tangible before allowing it to block a great people's movement, going on to speedily success.

Just permit me to recall a few facts, which a glance at some old files of newspapers will corroborate: In 1886, when the National Sanitarium Association appeared before the Ontario Government, asking for aid, they stated that it was their intention to establish a home for consumptives or near the city of Toronto, and this promise gained them financial support from Toronto financiers; but they did nothing for the Toronto poor.

In 1887 they asked for the 40c allowance from the city for poor patients to be sent from Toronto to Gravenhurst. This was refused on the ground that Gravenhurst was not in the best of the city of Toronto, and still the promise of 1886 was unkept.

In 1888, backed by a resolution from 82 of the foremost medical men of Toronto, a call was issued for a public meeting to be held on Oct. 14, to discuss ways and means to provide treatment for the consumptive poor of Toronto.

The day before the meeting, a circular letter was sent to those interested, stating that the trustees of the National Sanitarium Association have published the same day in the Globe (Oct. 13, 1888), in which he stated that the trustees of the National Sanitarium Association are taking steps to establish a home in or near Toronto; a meeting of the association was to be held on the 14th, when plans for the same would be submitted. "I have every reason to believe that in another month a home to accommodate 50 people will be under way," are his words.

Months went on, with nothing done. In April, 1889, a delegation from the Citizens' Sanitarium Committee appeared before the Board of Control, asking for a bylaw for \$25,000 for a Toronto Sanitarium for Consumptives. This was again met by an offer from the National Sanitarium Association to build and equip a sanitarium for the same purpose, "for which \$25,000 had been subscribed," in their own words.

The result was that the bylaw was held in abeyance to give them time to work. The National Sanitarium Association went on its way like "Bee's Rabbit," "not doing" for the Toronto consumptive poor. In August, 1890, the National Sanitarium Association once more offered to treat poor Toronto patients in Gravenhurst, if the city would give the usual 40c allowance. Dr. Sheard's report, which recommended the experiment, and it was granted. To show how effectively the Toronto poor consumptives can be treated in Gravenhurst, Dr. Sheard's report stated that two (2) persons have availed themselves of this offer, while over 600 of Toronto's population have died of the disease.

In February, 1900, the secretary of the National Sanitarium Association informed me that he had decided not to establish a sanitarium near Toronto, but to concentrate in Gravenhurst.

In March the Citizens' Committee waited on the Government, asking for comprehensive legislation of the kind which has been the Toronto "Anti-Consumption League," and enlarged its scope to a systematic campaign to lead the people to cure Toronto of consumption, and to meet the opposition from the National Sanitarium Association, the Ontario Legislative Assembly unanimously passed the legislation now on the statute books, making general provision for the establishment of a system of sanitariums for consumptives for
