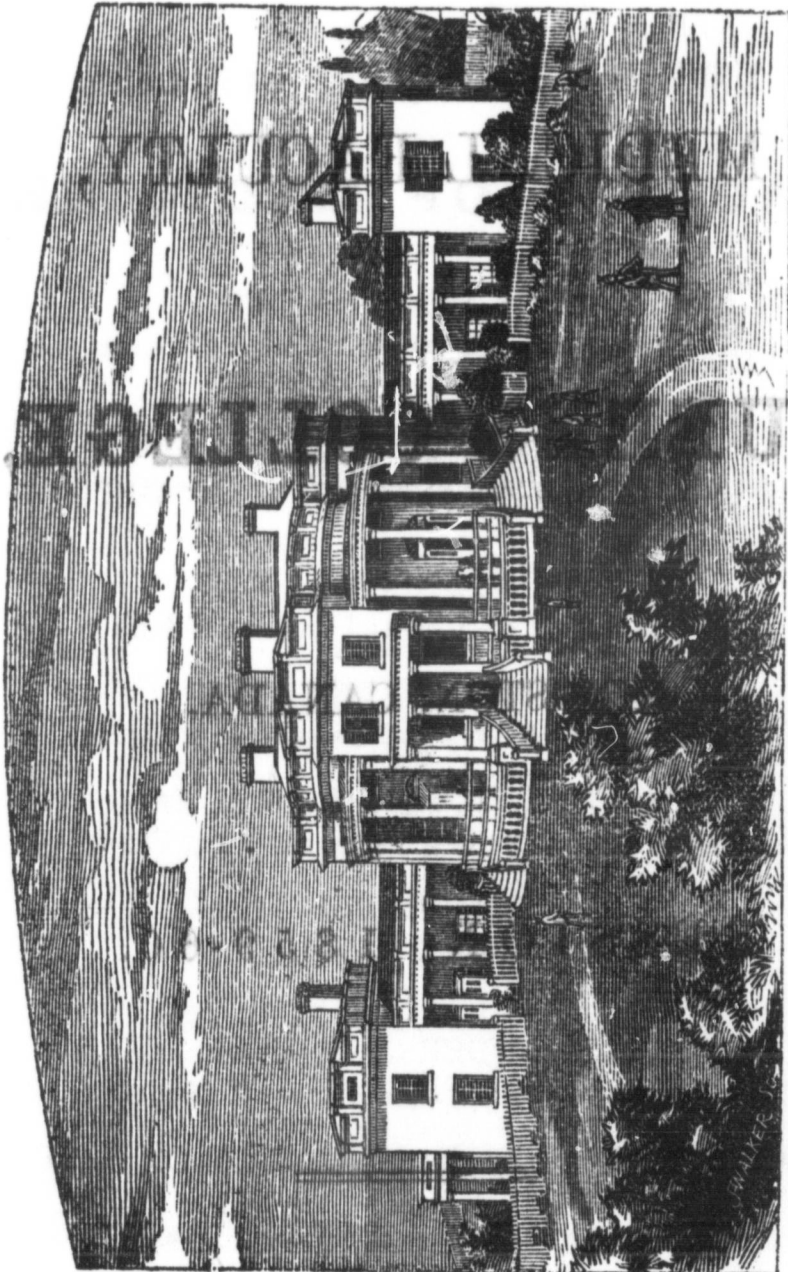

**FACULTY OF MEDICINE,  
Queen's College.**

THE sixth Session of the Medical Faculty of the University of Queen's College will commence on the first Wednesday of November, 1859, and terminate the last week of April, 1860.

The following is the course of study required for the Degree of Doctor of Medicine:---

The candidate for Graduation must have been at least **FOUR YEARS** engaged in the acquisition of professional knowledge; and, during that time, must have attended, for **THREE SESSIONS**, Lectures in some recognized Medical School.

**ONE YEAR** engaged in the study of Medicine, with a respectable medical practitioner, previous to the **THREE SESSIONS'** attendance on Lectures, will be equivalent to attending Lectures a fourth Session. One Session, at least, must have been passed in the University; during which time each of all the above-named Classes must have been attended.

The candidate will be required to give proof, previous to his examination, of his classical attainments\*; and to present to the Faculty a Thesis, written by himself, on some medical subject.

He must be twenty-one years of age before receiving his Degree.

Certificates of attendance on Lectures will be received from incorporated Medical Schools in the British dominions; and, also, from others recognized by the British Colleges. Other certificates of attendance on Lectures will be admitted at the discretion of the Faculty.

\*The Latin examination does not take place until the end of the curriculum, unless the Student desire it. The London Pharmacopœia, or Gregory's Conspectus, or, if the Student prefer, Cæsar's Commentaries, are the works examined in.

Five Lectures a-week, each of an hour's duration, will be delivered on each of the six months' courses.


Regular attendance on Lectures will be compulsory.

The Class Fees are \$12 for each Class of five Lectures a-week, and of six months' duration, payable at the commencement of the Session. The Fees of Classes of fewer Lectures, and of less duration, will be proportionately less. The Graduation Fee is \$30, and the annual Matriculation Fee \$2. Tickets must be registered with the Secretary of the Medical Faculty.

The Kingston General Hospital may be attended by the Students of Queen's College, during their whole period of study, on payment of £1 at the commencement of the course. Four members of the Medical Faculty will be the medical attendants of the Hospital; and will thus have it in their power to afford Clinical instruction.

By an Act of the Province, the bodies of the convicts of the Provincial Penitentiary are given up for anatomical purposes. This gives to Kingston very great advantages for the study of anatomy.

To meet the wants of the rapidly increasing number of Students, a spacious building has been erected, adjoining the University, which will afford every accommodation for study.

 The University of Queen's College being incorporated by Royal Charter, those possessing its Degree in Medicine will be entitled to their Provincial License, to practise Physic, Surgery, and Midwifery, by presenting their Degree to a District Judge, identifying themselves on oath as the persons named therein, and paying \$4—the fee now paid by British graduates in Medicine to the Provincial Secretary for a License to practise in the Province.

The University of Queen's College has the honor to inform that the classes of Lectures and of Dissections will be proportionately less. The Graduation Fee is \$30 and the annual Matriculation Fee \$2. Tickets must be registered with the Secretary of the Medical Faculty.

The Kingston General Hospital may be attended by the Students of Queen's College during their whole period of study, on payment of \$1 at the commencement of the course. Four members of the Medical Faculty will be the medical attendants of the Hospital; and will thus have it in their power to afford Clinical Instruction.

By an Act of the Province, the bodies of the convicts of the Provincial Penitentiary are given up for anatomical purposes. This gives to Kingston very great advantages for the study of anatomy.
