Bill to amend Chapter sixty-three of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, respecting Joint Stock, Manufacturing and other Companies.

WHEREAS, the discovery of Petroleum in large and paying quantities in various sections of this Province, makes it desirable that the Act chapter sixty-three of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, should be so amended as to authorize the organization of Companies for the purpose of boring for and using Petroleum, in the most expeditious and expensive manner: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :

Preamble.

I. Section one of the sixty-third Chapter of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada shall be and the same is hereby amended by inserting the word "Petroleum" between the words "salt" and "or" where it first occurs in the ninth line of the said section.
