Dean Reid, the young woman's husband, alleged that she was kidnapped while they were on their honeymoon and placed in the asylum under an old commitment signed six months ago by Judge Platt.

DEATH PAGE CARRIED OUT LETTERS REVEAL A TRAGEDY

Strange Agreement Between Miners Near Skagway—Skeleton of One is Found. Vancouver, B.C., Oct. 29.—A despatch from Skagway says: It is believed that James Murray, otherwise known as Moonrider, murdered his partner, James Fisk, last March, at Hailbut Bay, near Seldovia, while in the cabin of the steamer "Fisk". The skeleton of Fisk was found recently by natives, with a rifle ball in the back. It was identified by clothing and letters found on the body. In the cabin, twenty steps away, were found a bloodstain and a knife. There were blood stains on the furniture. Murray is supposed to have committed suicide as he has not been seen since last February. In a letter left in the cabin Murray says he had but a few hours to live. Then follow incoherent religious and socialistic utterances. Another, to an unnamed brother, says: "I wish you could see me to-day at 5 o'clock, and he is to be killed after me by my agency. All this is for wrongs in our past lives and for the sake of humanity. We have agreed to wipe out all scores of the past lives, and to do this we forgive one another as well as forgive our enemies."

LATEST NIAGARA FALLS HERO TO BE RAPIDLY ON THE WAY

Frank Bennett Thinks He Has Scientific Invention That Will Take Him Successfully Thru. Niagara Falls, Oct. 29.—Frank Bennett, a still walker, proposes to walk thru the rapids at Niagara Falls from Goat Island to the New York side on Nov. 12. He declared that by an invention that he has perfected the very elements that he would brave will aid him in his perilous journey. His plan is to weight a pair of attils with about 100 pounds of lead to make them cling to the bottom of the water, well knowing that a single step will be paid for by the weight of the lead. He has shaped the weights so that they will cling to the rocky bottom, and absolutely prevent his slipping or sliding to absolute destruction. His new stilt is armed with weights shaped like the inverted cutwater of a water wheel, and the water will press the bottom of the stilt to the rocky bottom, and prevent the danger of man losing his footing. "I cannot see that my plan is any more hazardous than that of Blondin, who not only walked a wire suspended over the Falls, but also carried a man on his back," says Bennett. "Blondin took his life in his hands and won enduring fame. I am not going to do anything less. I will walk a tight-rope from side to side of the Falls, and not only accomplish the feat, but he never ventured far more by taking a step than I will. I have, and thus doubly weighted, he walked the entire distance as the hair of a dog." "What I propose to do is a mere trifle beside that great feat. I shall walk along the wire with all the precautions I should carry out my purpose successfully. Of course, if I make a mistake, I will be in a bad way. I am not going to do anything less than to be dashed to death in the Falls, but that is a chance that every man who attempts to walk a tight-rope takes of this kind."

SPANISH CRUISER FOUNDERS

ONE OF 540 MEN RESCUED. Strikes Rock and is Lost—Resignation of Cabinet and What May Result. Madrid, Oct. 29.—The Spanish cruiser "Alfonso XIII" sank this morning at 6 o'clock off Muros. She was steaming to Ferrol and struck on a rock, Captain Diaz, who was at Manila during Admiral Dewey's attack, and all the officers and crew of 540 men, were rescued, but the ship could not be refloated. King Alfonso returned to Madrid from the scene of the failure. The ship was launched in 1899 and was of 7000 tons burden. She had 90 14-foot beam, drew 25 feet of water and cost \$2,000,000. The cruiser had eight inch guns, two 11-inch guns, eight 5.5-inch guns and a number of smaller guns. She was armed with torpedoes and had a crew of 540 men.
