MASSEY'S MUNIFICENCE. WHAT THE WILL OF THE LATE MILLIONAIRE PROVIDES. In Addition to Handsomely Equipping for His Family the Dead Man's Charity Bequeathed \$375,000 to Toronto Public Institutions, \$314,000 to Other Canadian Christian Establishments and \$60,000 to Deserving American Concerns—The Will in Detail.

The will of the late H. A. Massey has been given out for publication. The amount bequeathed to the charitable, educational and religious institutions is payable within 20 years and totals \$747,000, which, added to the \$400,000 he devoted to similar purposes during his lifetime, makes his total gifts totaling to the public over a million dollars.

The bequests to charitable, educational and religious objects are as follows: Victoria College, Toronto, \$200,000. Of this amount the sum of \$100,000 is for the erection of a suitable boarding hall and home for the students of the college. The remainder is mentioned in the will as follows: Wesleyan Theological College, Montreal, \$100,000.

Methodist Church, Toronto, \$100,000 towards the debt provided full amount is raised. Methodist Church, for and toward the erection of a new building of Deaconess Home, Training School and Hospital, on the grounds of the Metropolitan Church at such other place in Toronto as the executors may approve, of the sum of \$100,000.

None of these legacies or bequests bear interest, and as to the religious objects the executors and trustees have 20 years in which to pay them, and the will gives the executors the discretion that no funds are to be withdrawn from any of the several business enterprises in which Mr. Massey was connected, to the detriment of those business interests, unless and until it is deemed wise and best to do so in the sole discretion of the executors and trustees.
