EVERY LIBERAL FEARS AN INQUIRY INTO THE FORGERIES. Verily Heady with Pleasant Revelations. Irish Prisoners at Chatham Treated Worse Than American Slaves.

LONDON, May 10.—In every way sensational is the Bluebook report issued today by the special committee appointed to inquire into the cruel treatment of American dynamites confined at Chatham Prison.

The Tories are talking loudly about Parnell not insisting on a select committee to inquire into the forger conspiracy and the attempt of the Government to suborn the evidence of dynamites and other prisoners against him.

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FIRST EDITION. WHAT ENGLAND IS DOING.

GLADSTONE'S DISAPPOINTMENT AT THE PROGRESS OF THE DOCTRINE. Free Trade Prospects Not by any Means Encouraging, but he had Hope of their success.

LONDON, May 12.—Mr. Gladstone spoke at the Golden Club today. He said free traders must recognize, with great disappointment, how much ground had been lost by their doctrine within the last twenty-five years.

At one time there had been a kind of qualified progress towards them but this was being checked. Opinion being advanced retrograde, and the growing strength, activity and clearness of conviction of the free trade American party gave favorable promise of ultimate triumph at the polls.
