EXTRAORDINARY MARRIAGE CEREMONY.—Since Monday last the neighbourhood of St. John's Church, St. John's square, Clerkenwell, has been the scene of great interest and excitement, in consequence of a ceremony of a most novel and extraordinary character taking place, of which the following are the particulars. It appears that the Rev. Mr. Hugh Hughes, minister of St. John's Church, in the course of his visits to relieve the poor in lower walks of life, and attend their religious and moral wants, discovered a great number of persons living together in a state of concubinage and profligacy.
