GREAT FIRE AT WINNIPEG.

EIGHTEEN OR TWENTY BUILDINGS DESTROYED.

A Space Covering Nearly Three Acres

Reduced to a Mass of Smouldering Ruins

The Opera House, Salvation Army Barracks and Many Stores Destroyed

A Theatrical Company's Loss. WINNIPEG, May 1.—The most extensive fire in the history of Winnipeg occurred about 2 o'clock this morning, and before it was got under control 18 buildings were totally destroyed, a space covering nearly three acres now being a mass of smouldering ruins.
