THE REDUCTION OF THE DRILL.

It was announced in The World yesterday that the Minister of Militia had notified the various city corps of militia throughout the Dominion that they should be drilled only once every six months.

Minister's Office, Ottawa, 1st August, 1895. My Dear Sir,—I very much regret to say that although I have on several occasions, and once in Parliament, expressed my view that I should be able to give the city corps a full 12 days' drill this year, I find that with the present state of the treasury the only way I can carry out my intention is to reduce the drill to eight days.

The very large reduction made in the previous year for other services for service has rendered it impossible for me to draw assistance from any other source.

I write you this personally because of the erroneous impression which you have received from my own mistake statements.

The case stands thus: When Parliament was sitting three months since a rumor was circulated and not without foundation that the pay for the city corps would be reduced, if not altogether withheld.

This rumor was disseminated by the officers of the corps, and it was not until an official communication was received from Ottawa, stating that both the rate of pay and the amount of drill would remain as usual, no action was taken, or even intimated.

The opinion of the Legislature, as expressed in the second act, which was passed on the 23rd of March, is in favor of the proposal.

It is hoped that the operation of this clause will do away with the professional race-horsing of the farmers and tend to promote the development and encourage the breeding of sound, stylish, high-class horses.
