

To the Clerks of the Peace.

SIR.

It is probable, from the advanced period of the year, that the Statutes of the present Session may not be published in time to enable the Selectors of Jurors to procure them and perform their duties within the time prescribed for that purpose.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL has therefore been pleased to direct me to call your particular attention to the alterations made in the Jurors' Act of 1850, by the Bill passed during the present Session, in order that the necessary steps may be taken to ensure the Jurors' Books for 1852 being properly completed according to its provisions.

I am further directed by His Excellency to transmit copies of such of the Sections of the Jnrors' Act of 1850, as have been altered as they stand amended by the Bill of 1851, together with the new provisions of the latter. So that parties having copies of the Act of 1856 will only have to substitute the amended Sections for the original ones in such copies to have the law as it will stand under the operation of both.

I am also commanded to direct that you address a circular to the Heads of the different Municipal Corporations within your County or Union of Counties, as you were directed to do last year, calling their attention to the 11th Section of the Jurors' Act, as amended, and recommending that they should notify their brother Selectors respectively, of the time and place of meeting for the performance of their duties, noticing particularly that the period fixed by the amendment for the meeting of the Selectors is the 1st of September, instead of the 8th of that month. In your circular to such Officers, you will also request that the Selectors should endorse on their Reports, for the information of the Government and Parliament, if it should call for such Returns.

1st. The amount of Assessment which they found to be that necessary to qualify Jurors for such local division of the County according to the 4th section of the Act.

2nd. The number of Jurors selected under each division of their Report and the total of such numbers.

3rd. The number of persons on the Assessment Rolls whom they found, though otherwise qualified to be elected, disqualified to be so under the 9th and 10th sections.

4th. The number of persons on such Roll whom they found qualified, but exempt from being selected under the 5th and 6th sections.

5th. The number of persons on such Roll not qualified in respect of property, and

6th. The whole number of persons on such Assessment Roll.

The necessary expense incurred by you in taking these steps on the present occasion you may charge in your general account.

I am further commanded to direct that immediately after the completion of the Jurors' Books for 1852, you will make a return to me in a tabular form, for the information of His Excellency, of

1st. The amount of Assessment which, according to the returns of the different Selectors of Jurors for the different Cities, Towns, Villages and Townships in your County or Union of Counties, was found to be that necessary to qualify Jurors for such City, Town, Village or Township, according to the 4th section of the Act.



2ndly. The number of Jurors selected for each of such Cities, Towns, Villages and Townships, under divisions corresponding with those of the Reports of Selectors, and the total of such numbers both in each City, Town, Village and Township, and in the whole County or Union of Counties.

3rd. The number of persons on the Assessment Rolls of each of such Cities, Towns, Villages and Townships respectively, found disqualified under the 9th and 10th sections of the Act, with the sum total of such disqualified persons.

4th. The number of persons on such Rolls respectively, found qualified but exempted from being selected under the 5th and 6th sections, with the sum total of such exempted persons.

5th. The number of persons on such Rolls respectively, not qualified in respect of property, with the sum total of such persons.

6th The whole number of persons on each of such Rolls respectively.

7th. The whole amount of the Assessed Property on such Rolls respectively, with the sum total of such Assessments: and

8th. The whole number of inhabitants in such City, Town, Village or Township, with the sum total of such inhabitants in the County or Union of Counties.
