x.--The Officers of the Institution shafl be a President, two of the oflcers. Vice-Presidents, an Honorary Secretary and a Treasurer, who shall be elected from the Board of Governos,
2.-The Board of Governors (ghl of whom shall we Protes- op the Eoarl of tants) shalt be composed of the Lite Governors, of not less than Governers. twenty-four Elective Governors, and of sueh persons ns may, from time to time, be appointed Goveruors by nny Protestant Church or Congregation, or by any Soeiety as contemplated in the 5th reetion of the Aet of Ineorporation, and subject to the limitations hereinafter provided.
3.--The Joard of Management slanll cousist of the President, of hac Boerd of the two Vice-Presideuts, the Honorary Secretary, the Treasurer, Janagement. and not less"than twenty-four members; and the President and Vice-Presidents of the Bourd of Governors shall also be President and Vice-Presidents of the Board of Management.
4.--It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all of cha President General Meetings of the Institution, as well as at all meetings of the Board of Governors, and to preserve order thereat. He shall not vote exeept in case of a tie, in which case he shall give the casting vote.
5.-It shall be the duty of the senior Viee-President, or, in op the The Frehis absence, or the second Viee-President present at any General sidente. Mecting of the Institution, or at any Meeting of the Board of Governors, to preside in the absence of the President, and to perform, for the time being, all the functions of that offiee. In case of the absence of all these Offiecrs, thea the Meeting shall choose their own Chairman.
16.-It shall be the duty of the Honorary Secretary to attend of che Honorary at all Mectings of the Governors, take minutes of the proceed- secretary. ings thereof, and transeribe, or cause the same to be transeribed, into a book to be kept for that purpose. He shall read the said minutes at the sueceeding Meeting, and obtain thereto the signature of the Chairman. Through the Honorary Seeretary all communications of whatsoever nature shall be made to the Board of Governors, and by him to the publie and to the"Board of Hanagement. He shall give notice in writing to Governors
T.- The Treasurer shall give kuch security as may he required by the Governors for the due accounting for ali monies, bonds, title deeds, doemments or other papers cutronsted to and received by him. He shall deposit the said monies in one of the Chartered Banks of the city, in the name of the Corporation, and shall pay out the whole or any part thereof under the direction and anthority of the Boarl of Management, lout not otherwise. All checures shall be signed by the President, or, in his absence, by either of the Vice-Presidents, nud countersigned by the Secretary of the Board of Management. The Treasures only whall have the custody of atl monies, honds, deeds, documents and other papers relating to his department, and he shab deliver to the Secretary of the Board of Management, three days at least prior to each Anmal General Meeting, af full and correct statement for the year of all his aceounts, with the vouchers, de. said statement to be laid before such Amanal Meeting.
8.-It shall be the duty of the Secretary to be appointed by the Board of Management, as hereihafter provided, to keep ragular minutes of the procedings at all thedr Mectings, as well us of the Sub-Committees, and to lay the Minute Book contair. ing tile same before the Board of Governors at each of theis Meetings. He slall also give written notice to caeh nember of the Board of Management of all mectings. All accounts of expenditure shall pass through his hands and shall be laid by him once a montl before the Board of Management for theis examination and approval, preparatory to their being diseharged ly the Treasurer; and he shall keep a correct account in the hook of the Corporation, of all reccipts and expenditures.
9.-All Elective Officers of the Corporation shall hold office op Perm of oflae until the next Annual Meeting after appointment. the employment of the same, shall give three months notice in tion of service writing to the Board of Management of his or her intention so paide opicersal to do; and it shall be competent to the Board of Management io terminate the engagement of any officer in the employ of the Corporation, either by giving him three montins notice in writing to that efficet, or by paying him a sum of money equal to three montlis' salary in liel of sueh notice. In case of miseonduet, however, on the part of any person in the employ of the Compration, the Doard of Management may summarly disuiss
the person guilty of such misconduct without any previous notice; and in such case the salary of the person dismissed shall only be paid up to the time of his dismissal.
