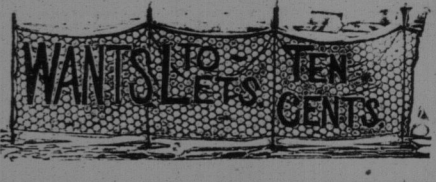

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QUEBEC BOODLING. HOW MR. PACAUD GOT \$100,000. Starting Disbursements Before the Senate Committee Yesterday.

OTTAWA, Aug. 15.—The senate committee met today. The first witness was the reading of a telegram from Mr. Garrison, commissioner of works, Quebec, who said that the Quebec government was responsible to the legislature, and declined to answer to the federal parliament for its proceedings.

Francis Langlois, counsel for Mr. Merzic, read a medical certificate for Mr. Merzic's condition, and also a certificate for Mr. Langlois. He also read a letter from Mr. Langlois to Mr. Merzic, dated July 15, 1891, in which Mr. Langlois advised Mr. Merzic to go to the United States.

The first witness was Mr. Dumoulin, who is Quebec agent of the Banque de la Peuple. His testimony was somewhat in the nature of a confession, and he admitted that he had received \$100,000 from the Quebec government.

Mr. Dumoulin was asked how the money was paid to him, and he replied that it was paid in three checks, each for \$33,333.33. He also admitted that he had received \$100,000 from the Quebec government.
