A Year Without a Summer.

The year 1816 was known throughout Europe and the United States as the coldest ever experienced within the degree of latitude which bound these countries. Very few persons now living can recollect it. The following is a brief abstract of the weather during each month of that year:

January was mild; so much so that it was called the winter of the partridge. February was not very cold; with the exception of a few days, it was mild as its predecessor. March was cold and boisterous during the first part of it; the remainder was mild. A great freshet on the Ohio and Kentucky rivers caused immense loss of property. April began warm, but grew colder as the month advanced, and ended with snow and ice and a temperature more like winter than spring.

May was more remarkable for frosts than smiles. Buds and fruits froze, ice formed half an inch thick; corn was killed, and the fields, again and again, were replanted until deemed too late.

June was the coldest ever known in this latitude. Frost and ice were common. Almost every green thing was killed, and fruit was nearly all destroyed. Snow fell to the depth of ten inches in Vermont, seven in Maine, three in the interior of New York and some parts of Pennsylvania. Indian corn was nearly all destroyed, although some favorably situated fields escaped. This was true of some of the hill farms of Massachusetts.

August was more cheerful, if possible, than the summer months already past. It rained daily, more or less, for twenty consecutive days. Ice was formed half an inch thick. Indian corn was so frozen that the greatest part was cut down and dried for fodder. Very little corn ripened in the New England and Middle States. Farmers supplied themselves from the corn produced in 1815 for the seed of the spring of 1817. It sold at \$4 to \$5 per bushel.

Almost every green thing that was destroyed both in this country and in Europe; peculiarly so in France, where constant rains fell during the months of July August and September. The low grounds of France, became flooded, the crops were destroyed, and even on the higher lands the harvest was seriously injured. But for an abundant potato crop, famine, with all its horrors, would have been her lot. On Aug. 3rd, snow fell at Barnet, forty miles from London. Papers received from England stated "that it would be remembered by the present generation that the year 1816 was the year in which there was no summer."

September furnished about two weeks of the mildest weather of the season. Soon after the middle it became very cold and frosty and ice formed a quarter of an inch thick. October produced more than its share of cold weather, and frost and ice common. November was cold and blustering. Snow fell so as to make good sleighing. December was mild and comfortable. The above is a brief summary of "the cold summer of 1816," as it was called, to distinguish it from the winter, which was mild. Frost and ice were common in every month of the year. Very little vegetation matured in the Eastern and Middle States. The sun's rays seemed to be destitute of heat throughout the summer. All nature was clad in a sable veil, and men exhibited no little anxiety concerning the future of the year. The average wholesale price of flour during the succeeding year, in the Philadelphia market, was \$13 per barrel. The average price of wheat in England was 57 shillings per quarter. Great riots occurred all parts of Great Britain in 1817, in consequence of the high price of the staff of life.
