The Fall River textile council, represent ing 85,000 operatives, today presente a reguest to the Manufacturers' Asso ciation for an advance of ten per cent. The unfons base their demand on the prosperous condition of the industry and the unusually high price of cloth The cotton manufaoturers of New England advanced England advanced wages five per cent. last January and on May 1 a further increase of ten per cent. was granted. If the present demand is ac ceded to the total advance ehis year will be twenty-five per cent. The woolen mills also advanced wages fifteen per cent. last winter and spring, thereby swelling the number who re cefved higher pay to more than a quarter of a million textile workers inf the New England states.
