Mrs. Taft, the New Mistress at White House, Will Assume Obligations as Hostess of the Nation—Washington Social Centre.

(By Viola Rodgers.) Washington, D.C., March 7.—The inaugural fuss and feathers is over; the Teddy Bear has made way for the Billy Possum and there is a new mistress in the White House.
