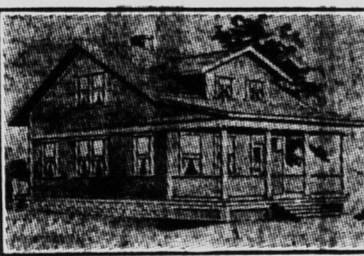

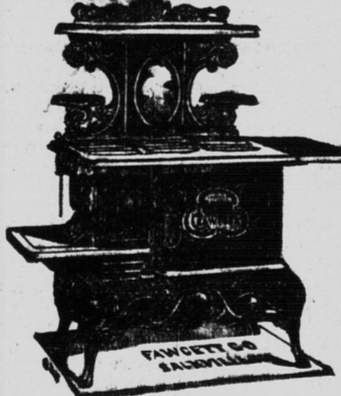

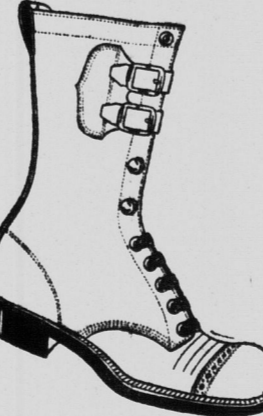

About two years ago, the duke sent a very handsome Christmas card to Byron C. Tapley, in the shape of a neat folder in terra cotta, having on the first leaf a circle cut out to reveal an English hunting scene on the second leaf.

Upon the second sheet, below the picture, is written in His Grace's handwriting: "A Happy New Year to you, From Argyll Xmas, 1912."

Many cordial letters were sent by the duke, a fac-simile of one of which is here given. The souvenir referred to in the steel pen used by Mr. Tapley in writing his work entitled "Sonata Britannica," which His Grace caused to be placed in historic Kensington Palace, London.
