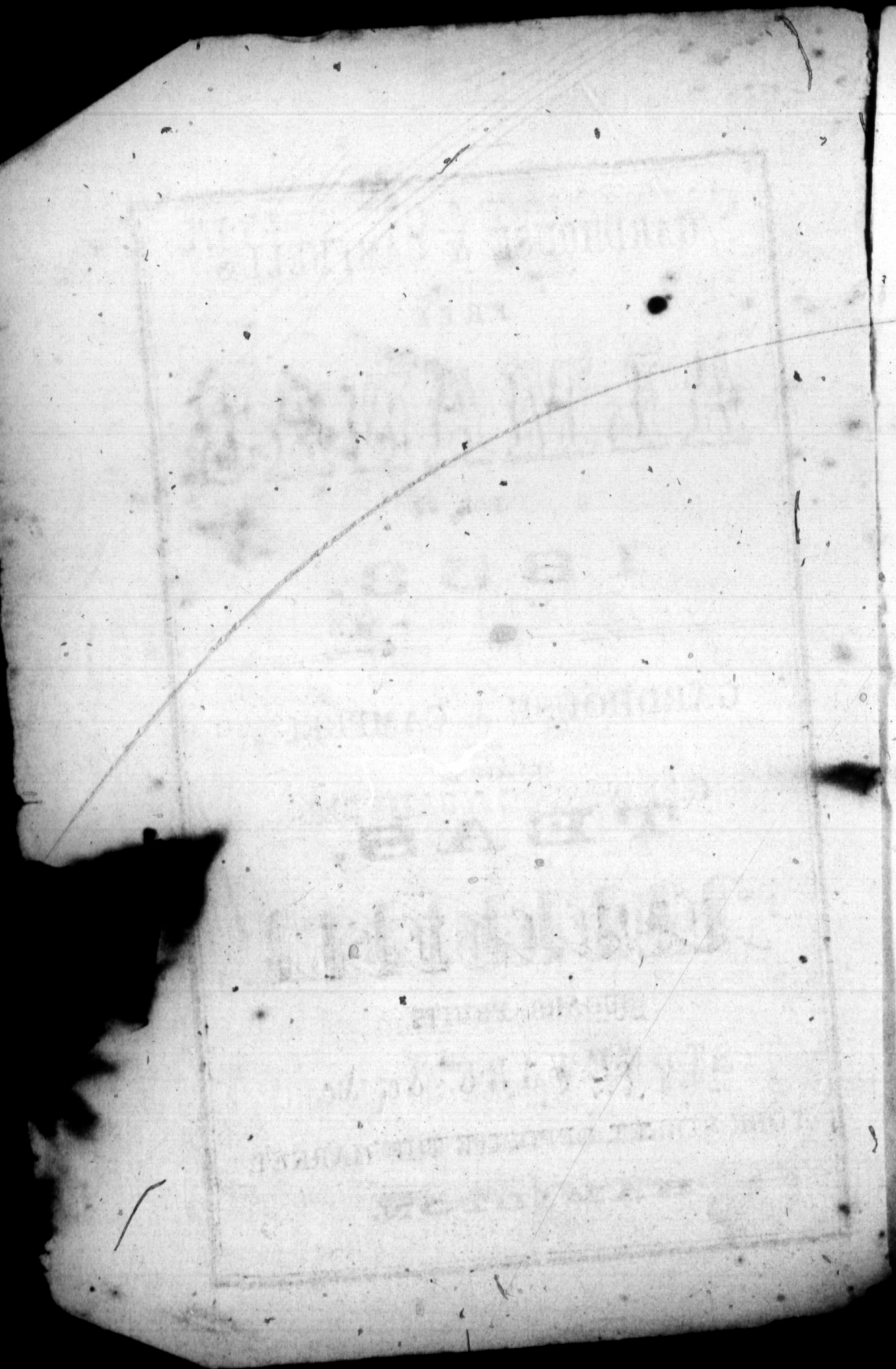

This year there will be two Eclipses of the Sun, and one of the Moon.

I. *An Annular Eclipse of the Sun, June 6th*, invisible at this place. This Eclipse will be visible in California, the southern portion of the United States, and nearly the whole of South America.

II. *A Partial Eclipse of the Moon, June 20th, and 21st*, visible as follows:

Eclipse ends, . . . June " 1h. 33m. A. M.		

Digits eclipsed, $2\frac{1}{2}$ on the Northern limb.

III. *A Total Eclipse of the Sun, November 30th*, invisible at this place. This eclipse will be visible in California, Mexico, Central America, and nearly the whole of South America.
