

II. A Partial Eclipse of the Moon, June 20th, and 21st, vielble as follows:

Eclipse begins, June 20th, 11h. 57m. P. M. Mean time Middle of eclipse, June 21st, 0h. 45m. A. M. Mean time Eclipse ends, June "1h. 33m. A. M. at Buffalo.

Digits eclipsed, 21 on the Northern limb.

III. A Total Eclipse of the Sun, November 30th, invisible at this place. This eclipse will be visible in California, Mexico, Central America, and nearly the whole of South America.
