HEAVY FORGERIES.

DISTRICT ATTORNEY IVES OF SALEM RESIGNS. LATEST CLEANING BY THE GAZETTE'S REPORTERS.

It is charged with several forgeries and pleaded guilty. He makes no effort to procure bail and is imprisoned.

Boston, April 25.—The Journal says the resignation of Mr. Geo. B. Ives, assistant district attorney of Essex county, was a topic of deep interest yesterday.

The members of the bar and the public officials were very excited, but the sentiment was very general that there would be no further proceedings.

All statements agree that considerable property is involved. The amount is said to be \$20,000, and the names forged were those of Solomon Lincoln and B. F. Fabens.

The complaint is made by the First National Bank of Boston, which held \$10,000 of the paper. It is also stated Ives has used up the job's estate of about \$90,000, and the Jonathan Blaney estate, of which he is trustee, to the amount of \$7,000 or \$8,000.

The money, he says, was used in extravagant living. Ives was immediately arrested and shortly afterwards he was arraigned before Judge Safford.

He pleaded guilty and was held for the superior court. Bail was fixed at \$100,000 in each case but the prisoner declined to make any effort to procure bonds and was taken to jail.
