

REPORT

OF THE

COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT.

The Committee of Management have the honor to present the 37th Annual Report of the proceedings of your Society, and in so doing must congratulate the Members on the assistance which the Society has been the means of providing in so many cases of distress during the past twelve months.

Felief has been afforded to (131) one hundred and thirty-one persons in all, and of these several were assisted to return to England. The Expenditure for charitable purposes is \$609.20. Of this amount \$31.25 went to defray the burial expenses in three cases of death.

In the Treasurer's Report will be found a statement of the financial affairs of the Society.

Our Membership Roll has been increased by the addition of two names, both Life Members.

The Society has to deplore the deaths, since its last Annual Meeting, of two of its Life Members, Mr. Charles Sharples and Mr. Joseph Auld. The usual Anniversary Service was held in the Cathedrat on the evening of St. Georges's Day, when an excellent sermon was preached by the Revd. M. M. Fothergill, and prayers read by the Revd. G. V. Housman, M.A., Chaptains to the Society. A very fine musical service was rendered by the Choir, the Choral Union, and several ladies and gentlemen amateurs, under the direction of Mr. F. W. Mills, F.C.O., late organist of the Church, to all of whom the Society is very much indebted for their valuable services. The collection in aid of the funds of the Society amounted to \$100.30.

Your Committee wish to refer to the rather frequent, practice prevalent with some Western Societies of sending persons down here at a trifling cost to themselves, and expecting your Society to forward them to England—an object not contemplated by the Society at all (except in cases of extreme age or infirmity.) and for which in any case the funds at our disposal are not sufficiently large.

Before closing this Report your Committee desire to bring under the notice of their successors the necessity of increasing the Membership of the Society. They would also, in the strongest manner possible, urge upon charitably-disposed Englishmen, and descendants of Englishmen, in our small community the desirability of their becoming Members of, and taking an interest in the proceedings of the Society, and thus doing what they can towards the succour and relief of their fellow-countrymen when they arrive among us friendless and destitute.

The Right Revd. George Jehosaphat Mountain, D. D., D. C. L., Lord Bishop of Quebec, was the second son of Bishop Jacob Mountain, the first Anglican Bishop of Qaebee. He was born 27th July, 1789, at Norwich, England, came to Canada with bis father, 1793, and died after a brief illness at Barfield, his country seat, on 5th Jany., 1863. He was nineteen years Rector of Quebee, and was consecrated Bishop, Jany., 1863. He was nineteen years Rector of Quebee, and was consecrated. Disnop, 14th February, 1856. He was a diligent visitor among his flock. And in the dreadful visitations of cholera in 1832 and 1834, he literally lived night and day among the dying and the dead, while in 1847, when the province was visited with the plague of typhus fever, and the poor emigrants were dying by thousands at the Quarantine station, the Bishop took his turn at Grosse Isle regularly with the rest of the clerzy; and again when the cholera visited Quebee, in 1849 and 1854, he was diligent in visiting the hospitals. During many years and up to the time of his death, Bishop Mountain, besides his life membership, contributed regularly to the Society a donation equal to four annual subscriptions, and at all times be took a great interest in its proceedings.
