



GENERAL POST OFFICE.

MONEY ORDER BRANCH OF NOVA SCOTIA.

GENERAL PRINCIPLES.

1. The Money Order System is intended for convenience of the Public, and to insure safety in transmission of money by means of the Post Office. Objects of the System.
2. Such transmission and payment is accomplished by means of printed *Orders* and *Advices*. The printed orders are given to persons applying and paying for the same, and are payable on presentation, according to address and Instructions. Explanation, of Orders and Advices.
3. The Advices are promptly forwarded by the issuing to the paying office; they convey names of payees and remitters, and statements of amounts payable. Advices.
4. Single Orders may be issued for any sum up to One Hundred dollars. If the transmission of more than one hundred dollars be required by one person at the one time, the additional transmission may be effected by issue of additional Orders. Amounts of Orders
5. Scales of Money Order amounts, with commissions chargeable thereon,—and lists of Money Order Offices, are furnished in accompanying appendix. Scales and Lists.
6. Money Orders are made out on printed forms supplied by the Chief Office; and only Orders so made out, are valid and payable. Printed Forms.
Money Order forms
7. Persons requiring Money Orders are to make application on forms provided for the purpose, and furnished by the issuing office. Applications.
8. Persons obtaining Money Orders should observe due care, in reference to the filling up and stamping of the same, so that difficulty and delay may be avoided. Examination of Orders.
9. Paying Postmasters should observe all proper means for being assured of the correctness of such transactions. Caution of Post Masters.

DIRECTIONS TO POST MASTERS OF MONEY ORDER OFFICES.

GRANTING ORDERS.

1. The person applying for a Money Order, will, on application, be supplied with a printed form, on which must be stated the particulars of amount, the *proper* Christian and Surnames, or initials of the former, and the address, required for the Money Order and Advice. Application for M. Orders.
2. The Post Master will, from the form of application, complete the Money Order, and Advice,—giving the former to the applicant, on payment of the sum expressed, and the prescribed commission. Completion of Money Orders.

3. On issue of a Money Order the Post Master will record the particulars in the Register of Money Orders issued, according to the form there provided. If repayment, or other subsequent action take place, in reference to the Order, he will make note of the same, opposite the entry in the Register.
4. The Post Master will transmit, by first following mail, the Advice of the Order, to the office on which it was drawn: with exception of Sterling Advices, which are forwarded to the Chief Provincial Office. See rules of Sterling Orders.
5. When a Money Order Office draws on another, in one day, for more than one hundred dollars, the Post Master so drawing is required to send notice of the transaction, to the Chief Office, stating the amount drawn for. (See form 24?)
6. The place of payment of a Money Order may be changed, by the issue of a new order, and payment of a new Commission. The Order originally granted will be withdrawn, and if the Advice has been forwarded, special Advice of the change will be transmitted by next post to the office drawn on.
7. Similar steps to those prescribed in Rule 6, may be taken to correct errors in reference to name, &c., of the Order issued.
8. *The issue of Money Orders on credit is strictly prohibited.*
9. Money Orders must only be drawn on Money Order Offices enumerated in the lists of such offices.
10. Advices of Money Orders, duly addressed, may be forwarded with or without envelopes.
11. *Names and sums of Orders and Advices, should be plainly written.*
12. When Orders are issued for amounts under one dollar, the space for dollars should be so marked by horizontal lines drawn through the space, as to prevent mistake or deception in reference to amount.
13. The forms of Money Orders and Advices are numbered consecutively. If any of them become spoiled, they will be marked *Cancelled*, with date attached,—and the Order so cancelled will be transmitted to the Chief Office with the Monthly accounts. The cancelled Advice will be retained by the Post Master. Every blank form in a Money Order book, must be strictly accounted for.
14. Money Orders and Advices require to be stamped at the Office of issue and of payment. If the stamp of the issuing office is wanting, the office drawn on will decline payment. Orders without stamps will not be considered as vouchers, but will be returned for completion.
15. Due care should be observed by Post Masters in reference to places drawn on, so that inconvenience and delay may be avoided.
16. Post Masters of M. O. Offices, will be held responsible for the official acts of their subordinates:—therefore great prudence should be observed in committing such concerns to others than themselves.
- Entries in Register.
- Transmission of Advice.

PAYING ORDERS.

17. On receipt of Money Order Advices, Post Masters will promptly enter particulars of the same in the Advice Register, and will file away the Advices for easy reference.
18. On presentation of a Money Order for payment, the Post Master will examine the document itself, in reference to stamping,

signing, &c., will compare it with record in Advice Register; and take such other means as may seem requisite for assuring himself of the correctness of the transaction. If the payee be unable to write he may sign by his "mark," duly witnessed.

19. Payment of Money Orders for sums exceeding one hundred dollars, may be deferred, if funds are not available for paying the same;—the delay is intended to afford opportunity for providing funds, from the Chief Office or otherwise.

Authorized delay.

20. When a Money Order is paid, the Post Master will write the date of payment in the Advice Register,—and the word "paid" in the space for remarks.

Record of Payment.

21. Post Masters should not pay any Money Order without reception of Advice, nor to any but the payee, without proper assurance of the correctness of the transaction. The signature of payees must be attached to orders, except, in case of absence or indisposition, written authority be held by some other person, to sign for the payee and to draw the money.

Caution concerning Advice & Payment.

22. A Post Master may pay M. Orders, received by payees, to other persons, provided he is duly satisfied that the transaction is perfectly genuine.

Payment to others than Payees.

23. The receipted order will be carefully filed, and will be held as sufficient voucher that the money is duly paid; it relieves the office from any additional claim on the transaction.

Vouchers of Payment.

REPAYMENT OF ORDERS.

24. Money Orders may be repaid to remitters of the same. The word *Re-paid* will be written in the margin of Advice Register. If the Advice of an Order for which repayment is required, has been forwarded to the office drawn on, the issuing Post Master will forward a special Advice of Repayment to that office; and on receipt of any similar Advice he will make due note of the same in his advice register, writing the word "*repaid*" and the name of place, and date of repayment. For repayment of Sterling Orders, the previous return of Advices is requisite.

Repaying of Orders

25. Orders repaid must be signed by the remitters, when they themselves apply for payment:—if repayment be required by other persons, the orders should be endorsed, and the same care to insure correctness should be observed, as is directed in Rule 21.

Signing and Caution in repaying Orders.

LOST ORDERS.

26. If the Remitter of an Order lose the same, or if it be lost before reaching the Payee, and if remedy be applied for, the issuing Post Master will refer the case to the P. M. Gen. or Superintendent of Chief M. O. Office, who, if satisfied of correctness of the representation, will cause transmission of a duplicate order to said Post Master, which will be given to the remitter, on his signing the required guarantee, and paying a new commission.

Loss by Remitter.

27. If an order be lost by the Payee, and he apply to the paying Post Master, that officer will refer the case, as in preceding rule, and will, on presenting a duplicate, take the usual guarantee, and new commission, and file away the receipted Order.

Loss by Payee.

28. The Post Master may require additional security to the guarantee, and the person becoming security will sign at the place indicated in Form No. 25.

Security.

LAPSED ORDERS.

Lapsed Orders.

29. When several months elapse between the date of an Order and its presentation for payment, Post Masters will observe much caution in reference to the alleged circumstances, taking, if requisite, a few days for that purpose. Subsequent to one year after date, Orders become "lapsed," and if they be presented for payment, the Post Master will refer the cases, with explanatory particulars, to the Post Master General or Superintendent: renewal of lapsed orders require payment of new commission.

FUNDS.

Funds required.

30. If Post Masters have not sufficient funds, in special cases, they may avail themselves of general receipts of the Post Office, noting the amounts so used in their quarterly accounts, or they may apply to the Chief Office for remittances *required*, stating *particulars* of requirement in their requisition.

Retention of funds, to meet demands.

31. Post Masters of M. O. Offices, may retain in their hands, of M. O. Monies, to meet demands, a sum of \$100. All monies above \$100, should be *promptly* transmitted to the Chief Office, whence, acknowledgements will be sent in return. The acknowledgement becomes a voucher to the Post Master, and should be carefully filed accordingly.

Remittance of Monies.

32. Remittances should be addressed to the Superintendent of Chief M. O. Office. Post Masters are required not to remit uncurrent Money of any kind to the Chief Office.

Current Money.

ACCOUNTS.

M. O. Accts. and their address.

33. M. O. Accounts should be kept distinct from those of the General Post Office revenue, and should be addressed to the Superintendent.

Books of M. O. Offices.

34. Books of Acct. are forwarded by the Chief Office:—They consist of, 1st, A Register of Money Orders issued and of Money Order Advices received. 2nd, A Cash Book for exhibiting the debit and credit transactions of each day. (See appendix.)

Cash Book.

35. In writing up the Cash Book:

- I. Bring forward the Debit balance.
- II. Cash supplies received from the Chief Office, if any.
- III. Totals of Money Orders issued for the day.
- IV. Commissions received on Orders.
- V. The balance, if any such be on the debit side.

The Credit side should exhibit:

- I. Money Orders paid.
- II. Orders repaid, if any.
- III. Remittances to the Chief Office on Order Account.
- IV. The balance.

(For Form of Cash Book, see appendix.)

Balancing of Cash Book.

36. The Cash Book should be carefully written up and balanced, each day.

Numbering and writing of Accts.

37. Accounts should be numbered, consecutively, commencing at the commencement of each year. They should be written legibly, so as to prevent difficulty in decyphering the same.

Quarterly Accts.

Quarterly Accounts terminate on Dec. 31, March 31, June 30, and September 30, respectively.

RETURNS.

38. On the concluding day of each Month, or as soon subsequent as practicable, Post Masters will prepare and transmit, to the Chief Office :

Monthly Returns ;

I. A list of Money-Orders issued during the month.

What they Com-
prise.

II. A list of Money Orders paid, during the same period.

III. An Acct. current, exhibiting the general aggregate of Money Order transactions. (See appendix).

IV. Paid Orders as vouchers of Accts.

If no M. O. business be transacted for the month, a form of acct. current, stating the circumstance, should be transmitted.

39. Accounts should be accurate in reference to commencement and termination of each month, and to all Money Order transactions of the month.

Commencing and
closing of monthly
Accounts.

40. Quarterly abstracts of Money Order transactions should be transmitted, statedly, to the Chief Office. If a Money Order Office does not transact any business of the department during the quarter, the blank forms, with the words "no business" written across, should be forwarded.

Quarterly Abstracts

COMMISSIONS.

41. Commissions, or fees, charged on issues of Money Orders, should be credited in full to the department each month ;—and at the close of each quarter the Post Master will credit himself with half the amount of Commissions so received ; except in cases of sterling Orders. (see appendix.)

Commissions, how
arranged.

FORMS.

42. A list of forms is appended. Care should be taken to avoid loss or waste of forms. They are supplied by the Chief Office, and Post Masters should apply for the same, duly, so as to prevent exhaustion of stock, before renewal.

Forms.

DELAYS AND ERRORS.

43. Negligence in transmitting Money Order balances, or monthly and quarterly returns, should be *very carefully* avoided by Post Masters. They should also, carefully observe and duly report any serious departure from Money Order routine with which they become acquainted.

Accuracy and Punc-
tuality.

44. Post Masters should advise with the Superintendent, or the Post Master General, concerning the treatment of any difficulties that arise ; and they are requested to make such suggestions for improvement of the System as experience may dictate.

Consultation and re-
port by P. Masters.

STERLING ORDERS.

ISSUING STERLING ORDERS.

Expression of Sterling.

I. Money Orders issued on the United Kingdom, on Canada, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, and P. E. Island, should be, without exception, expressed in Sterling money, and not in dollars and cents.—When the amount is under pounds, the space for pounds should be marked by heavy horizontal lines, so as to prevent error or deception.

Limitation of places of Issue.

II. The issue of Money Orders on the U. Kingdom, is limited to the *Hulifax Office*; issues on other offices enumerated are allowed to all the Money Order Offices of the Province.

Limitation of Amount.

III. Single Money Orders are limited to the amount of *Ten pounds*, sterling. Additional sums may be provided for by means of additional Orders.

Rules in force.

IV. *Forms and Rules*, of the general System, not specially superceded, will be in force in reference to Sterling Orders.

Names of Remitters and Payees

V. If the Remitter or Payee, be a Peer or a Bishop, his usual title is sufficient. A company may be designated by the name of the persons composing it, according to usual practice.

Transmission of Advices

VI. Advices of Sterling Orders must be forwarded promptly to the Chief Office, for special transmission. The Chief Office will register and stamp such advices.

COMMISSIONS.

VII. For Scale of Commissions, See Appendix. Post Masters are allowed $\frac{1}{4}$ of 1 per cent, on Sterling Orders issued and paid.

PAYING.

Stamps & Vouchers

VIII. Sterling Money Order Advices must bear the stamp of the Chief Office, as well as the stamp of the Issuing Office. Colonial Orders paid should accompany the monthly accounts, as vouchers. Accounts of Sterling Orders should be kept distinct from those of Local Orders, should be very accurately and plainly made out, and should be sent promptly at the stated times, to the Chief Office.

Repayment of MO

IX. On repayment of a Sterling Order being required, the Post Master will, before payment, refer the Case to the Chief Office.

Lapsed Orders

X. Sterling Orders become lapsed, twelve months after date. If payment be subsequently sought, applications, accompanied by the Advices, must be referred to the Chief Office.

Relief from claim.

XI. The due payment of a Money Order, by whomsoever presented, relieves the Office from all additional claim on the transaction.

LOST ORDERS.

Lost Orders

XII. On application concerning Lost Orders, the Post Master will refer the case to the *Chief Provincial Office*. If an Order on the U. Kingdom be lost, or has failed to reach the Payee, the Super-

intendant will direct the remitter to cause application by the Payee, through the Office drawn on, to the Chief Office of the division of the U. Kingdom to which the paying office belongs. Thus, Orders drawn on England, are referred to the London Office,—those on Ireland, to Dublin,—those on Scotland, to Edinburgh. To facilitate such applications the issuing Postmaster will hand applicant a slip, reciting the place of issue, date, number, amount, Office drawn on, and names of Payee and Remitter,—of the lost order. New commissions are chargeable on issue of duplicates.

TRANSACTIONS.

XIII. In making monthly statements, Sterling and local Orders, and the different classes of Sterling Orders, should be kept distinct. Much care should be observed in keeping such statements and accounts *clearly*, and in transmitting them *promptly* to the Chief Office.

Transactions to be kept distinct

XIV. Post Masters are held responsible for the proper payment of all classes of orders,—so that due care should be observed in paying monies and taking receipts. Orders payable to officials, on acct. of their departments, should have the official as well as the personal designation.

Cautions in paying Orders

XV. Rules relating to accounts, to returns, and to transmission of all surplus Money Order Cash, to the Chief Office,—are particularly called to the special attention of Post Masters.

NEW BRUNSWICK.

M. O. intercourse with Nova Scotia is conducted in Sterling.

The N. B. department has issued a scale for guidance of *its Postmasters*, by which appears, that to change pence sterling to currency, the pence are to be doubled for cents, up to 2s. 11d.;—three shillings, 73 cents; four shillings 97 cents; and so in proportion for intermediate amounts.

Also, for guidance of N. B. Postmasters, amount of Currency to be received for Money Orders drawn in N. B. on the Colonial Offices.
