An Act to regulate the sale and delivery of poisons and certain other drugs.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make stringent regulations concerning the Preamble. sale of poisons and certain other drugs within the Province; Therefore Her Majesty, etc., enacts as follows:

I. No apothecary, chemist, druggist, vender of medicines or other per- No apothe-5 son in this Province shall sell, give, or deliver any arsenic, corrosive sub-diac, to sell poisons withsolid, commonly known as poison, or which being incautiously or secretly out certificate administered may cause death, or chloroform or any substance known to from Justice of Peace or produce insensibility or stupefaction, to any person who shall not then Physician. 10 produce and deliver a certificate from some Justice of the Peace or Physician resident in the locality, in the form mentioned in Schedule Λ , or in some form equivalent thereto, addressed to such apothecary, chemist, druggist, vender of medicines or other person, mentioning the name, residence, calling or profession of the person requiring such poison or chloro-15 form or other drug, and stating the purpose for which it is required, and that it ought to be sold to the person requiring it; and such certificate Certificate to shall be kept by the person selling, giving or delivering such poison or drug be kept by vender. as his justification for so doing, and he shall cause the person bringing the same to write his name thereon, and the seller or giver shall also enter in his Purchaser to 20 day book or journal the name and quality of the person receiving such poison enter name, dec. in day or drug, the amount sold or given, the purpose and the name of the person book or jourgranting such certificate, and in the case of solids the poison shall be con-nal of vender. tained in a green colored wrapper, with the word poison written or printed thereon, and in the case of fluids each bottle or vial shall have a green label 25 with the same word written or printed thereon, and the same shall be followed in cases of chloroform or other stupefying drug, save that instead of poison, the name of the drug shall be written thereon; Provided always Proviso. that every person so selling or giving any such poison or other drug as aforesaid shall give a yearly return to the Clerk of the Peace for the Dis-30 trict or County within which he resides, of the names of the persons purchasing or receiving said poisons or drugs, and of the persons on whose

precautions herein mentioned, shall for each offence incur a penalty not Penalty.
