Power from Niagara Falls. The American Manufacturer, published at Pittsburgh, says that arrangements have been made within the past few days for quite a number of manufacturing enterprises scattered throughout Pennsylvania and New York to move their plants in order to secure power from the Niagara Falls Power Company. This great enterprise of utilizing the water-power at Niagara Falls and converting it electrically to points some miles distant has been pushed to almost completion. The company has taken a great number of contracts to furnish power for different plants beginning September 1. The city of Toronto will be profited largely by reason of its proximity to the Falls. The progress of electrical development at this great centre of power will be watched with interest by all, but to Toronto the harnessing of Nature's forces means more than we dare to dream. A 35-mile cable under Lake Ontario can give Toronto as much power as she can use. It will not be necessary to move our factories to the Falls. The spirit of the people will come to Toronto and work untold wonders. And it won't be a long time either.
