

WHOLE-SOME EDUCATION.

That excellent fellow, and good man the lamented Thomas Hood, has said: "Of all the know-nothings persons in this world commands it to the man who has 'never known a day's illness.' He is a moral dunces; one who has lost the greatest lesson in life, who has skipped the finest lecture in that great school of humanity, the sick chamber. Let him be versed in mathematics, profound in metaphysics, a ripe scholar in the classics, a bachelor of arts or even a doctor of medicine, yet is he as one of those gentlemen whose education has been neglected. For all this college acquirements, how inferior is he in whole-some knowledge to the mortal who has had a quarter's gout or a half-year's ague!—less infatuated below the fellow creature who has been soundly taught his ridiculous, thoroughly grounded in the rheumatics, and deeply red in the scrofulous fever! And yet what is more common than to hear a great, bulking fool follow bragging of an ignorance, a brutal ignorance, that he shares in common with the pig and the bullock, the generality of which die, probably, without ever having experienced a day's indisposition."

It seems that the aspect of affairs in the United States is not very favourable to the continuance of the union between the North and South. A Washington correspondent of the New York *Commercial*, in his last number, says: "It is no mistake to say that every section of society exists among the Southern politicians who are now disengaged with the Union and no disposition of the Kansas question will conciliate them. The Congress of the Southern legislative bodies is of the same character. Mr. Stephens, a member of the Virginia Legislature, and was a member of President Fillmore's Cabinet, and by no means an unconsiderate man, in a speech in the Legislature, lately, upon the subject of the intended improvements of the country, spoke of the dissolution of the Union as being about to take place, and thought rather seriously of it."

The effect of this upon the internal feelings of Virginia in any way connected with it, and instead of giving advantages to Baltimore, to bring trade down from the Ohio to Norfolk, which port the French line of steamers do not frequent. The approaching dissolution is not spoken of in any way, but the South as a matter which is settled, and is soon to be effected.
