**B I L L .**

An Act to repeal the Act for the regulating the Shipping of Seamen, and for other purposes therein mentioned.

**W**HEREAS by an Act of this Province, made and passed in the Session held in the tenth and eleventh years of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, "*An Act for regulating the Shipping of Seamen,*" it is declared that great frauds had been practised, and much inconvenience felt, from the system of shipping Seamen at the Port of Quebec, in that part of the Province which had theretofore constituted the Province of Lower Canada; and by the same Act power was given to the Governor, or the person administering the Government for the time being, to constitute and appoint, during pleasure, a fit and proper person to be Shipping Master for the said Port of Quebec; and it was further declared that a Deputy or Deputies should be appointed in the manner by the said Act directed; And whereas the said Act has not answered the end proposed, and it is expedient to repeal the same; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,
