ANNUAL REPORT, 1884.

The directors have the honor to submit their annual statement, giving the results of the business of the company for the year ending Dec. 31, 1884. They have the satisfaction to inform the shareholders that the business done in Canada shows a very handsome profit; and to state that the fire business done in Canada shows a loss ratio of only fifty-four and a half per cent., which may be considered a very gratifying result. It is to be regretted that the company's fire business in the United States has been unprofitable, but almost without an exception every large English and American company doing an agency business there has suffered an equal degree. In closing up the fire business in Europe and other foreign countries, under arrangements made by a former management, the company is still sustaining loss, but the shareholders will be pleased to know that the foreign business is now greatly reduced, and there is every reason to hope that future losses from that source will be comparatively light. The directors anticipate a satisfactory business during the ensuing year, as fire insurance companies were never more in a world with each other. Boards have been organized throughout the United States and Canada for the purpose of securing an increase in rates, and for the establishment of a better basis of insurance business generally. As the manufacturing and commercial interests of the country improve, the directors confidently look for a corresponding improvement in the business of fire insurance.
