SOME DEEP SEA WONDERS

THE WAY THEY ARE FOUND AS STRANGE AS WHAT IS FOUND.

The Water Lamb and Lion Lie Down Together in the Presence of the Glowing Electric Light-Keeping a Deep-Sea Lion Awake.

Few people eat fish at a depth of 300 feet. There are fewer fishermen at a depth of 4,500 fathoms, or 27,000 feet. This is a depth of about 1-1/2 miles.

The Albatorus is strictly a scientific fishing craft. She cost over \$100,000, is 224 feet long, and of 1,974 tons displacement, with a brigantine rig. Her hull is made of steel.

The light is sometimes lowered 300 feet from the surface. At a depth of 70 feet the illumination becomes invisible. When the light is 20 or 30 feet down and huge fish congregate about it their shadows are cast on the bottom.

It has been noted that the effect of the electric light upon fish has been such that as deadly enemies as a shark and the swordfish will swim up to the light side by side, and so amazed that they appear to forget the deadly feud existing between these placid families, and they do not rush at each other in mortal combat.
