FOUND FAME IN POLICE

COL. ARTHUR PERCY SHERWOOD HAS RISEN TO THE TOP.

"FREAK COMPANIES."

Some Remarkable and Amazing Examples of Financial Speculation.

Some interesting particulars regarding the promotion of "freak companies" were given in a paper read by Mr. H. W. Jordan, F.R.S., at Winchester House, London, on the occasion of the annual meeting of the Association of Limited Companies.

The lecturer, who took for his subject "The Promotion and Finance of Limited Companies," said that the earliest kind of joint-stock company was the Chartered Company, and through the agency of these companies many of the English colonies were first settled, the foundations of the Empire laid, and the foreign trade and commerce of the country mainly conducted.

As showing the comprehensive scope of the Company, and the diverse purposes to which it might be applied, the lecturer recalled a few curious promotions of "freak companies." He mentioned that one individual formed a company with a capital of £1 divided into 200 shares at £5 each, the registration fees for which amounted to about £4.
